With reference to above said subject matter In-principle approval has been issued vide above letter ref. 1 against diversion of 0.098 Ha. of Forest Land. 1	The cost of compensatory afforestation on the degraded CA land (1.00 ha) at the prevailing wage rates as per compensatory afforestation scheme (including the cost of survey, demarcation and erection of permanent pillars etc. as required for securing the land against encroachment) shall be deposited in advance with the State Forest Department by the project authority. 


