



In compliance of the Rule 6 (3) (e) of the Forest (Conservation) Rules, 2003 [as amended vide the Forest (Conservation) Amendment Rules 2014; Forest (Conservation) second Amendment Rules 2014; and Forest (Conservation) Amendment Rules 2016] it is certified that 131-05-10 Bighas (10.6240 Hectare) of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of Satluj Jal Vidyut Nigam Ltd. (SJVN) for the purpose of construction of Sunni Dam Hydro Electric Project falls within the jurisdiction of village(s) Jakleen in Tehsil Karsog. It is further certified that:

- (a) the complete process of identification and settlement of rights under the FRA, 2006 has been carried out for the entire 131-05-10 Bighas (10.6240 Hectare) of forest land proposed for diversion. A copy of records of all consultation and meetings of the Forest Rights Committee(s), Gram Sabha(s), Sub-Division Level Committee(s) and the District Level Committee are enclosed as annexure I to V.
- (b) the proposal for such diversion (with full details of the project and its implications, in vernacular/local language) have been placed before each concerned Gram Sabha or forest dwellers, who are eligible under the FRA, 2006.
- (c) each of concerned Gram Sabha (s), has certified that all formalities/ processes under the FRA have been carried out, and they have given their consent to the proposed diversion and the compensation and ameliorative measures, if any, having understood the purpose and details of proposed diversion. Copies of certificates issued by Gram Sabha(s) of Jakleen village are enclosed as attachment I to V.
- (d) the discussion and decision on such proposals had taken place only when there was a quorum of minimum 50% of the members of each Gram Sabhas present;
