1 Name: 137-Andheri-Gurdwara. Compartment-1.

Situation: Situated to North East of Gurdwara between Bhare and Bhurrey-Ka-Khala.

3 Boundries: N:-Bhare and Bhudrey-Ka-Khala.

E:-Zamindari Forest Land of village Bhandariwala and Bhudreya.

S:-Zamindari Forest Land/Cultivation of Gurdwara and Bhandariwala.

W:-Zamindari Forest Land of Gurdwara and Bhare-Ka-Khala.

4 Configuration:- Hilly, Undulating, intersected by Khalas and spurs badly eroded.

5 Locality Factors:-

a Altitude:

b Aspect: South-Eastern.

c Slope: Gentle to steep.

d Soil & Sub-soil: Stiff clay to sandy loam.✓

e Drainage: Satisfactory.

f Erosion: Severe.

6 General composition:-

This compartment supports almost open, dry deciduous mixed scrub having malformed, stunted trees of Chhal, Jhingan, Khair, Sala standing here and there. The area is badly eroded and gives a look of a highly degraded forest. Khair and Chhal trees are badly lopped. Bushes/seen here are Karonda, Thor, Dodonea, Kandai etc.

The area has been planted in the past but with little to moderate success. However, survival is better towards the South-Eastern end of the compartment, where there is a good patch of Khair and Chhal.

a Principal Spp : Chhal, Khair, Jhingan.
i Age class : Young to middle.
ii Quality : --
iii Stocking : Poor.

b Under wood : (Absent) Rare.

c Under growth : Kuri, Dhali, Dodonea, Karonda, Beri, Chilli etc.

e Ground cover : Grass, Dholu and Bhabbar, Sarala.

12 Special treatment prescribed :

Old plantation done in the area has failed. Hence the failed portion be taken up afresh for planting with Khair bamboo etc. along-with soil conservation measures.

* Plus Khair w.c. of 8.00 ha of plantation carried out during 1981-82 which has attained to comp. diameter of 9.51 cm as per regular measurements.
