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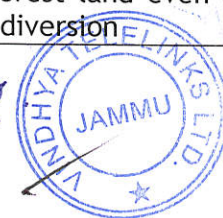

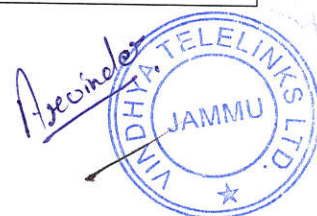

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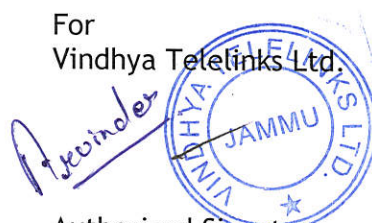

In compliance with the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India's letter No. 11-9/98-FC (pt) Dated: 3rd August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition) of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 (FRA,) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes read with MoEF's letter dated: 5th February 2013 wherein MoEF issued certain exemption/relaxation in respect of linear projects, it is certified that 0.97 hectares of forest land is proposed to be diverted in favour of **Laying of underground Optical Fiber Cable on Machedi Thall-Bhullari -**, in District Kathua. 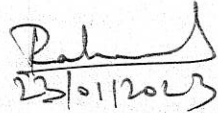
- (a) The complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire of 0.97 Hectares of forest area proposed for diversion. As per MoEF letter No. F.No. 11-9/98-FC (pt), Dated: 5th Feb. 2013 for linear projects like construction of roads, there is no requirement of resolution (meeting/consent) of Gram Sabha of that area for forest land, use of which is proposed to be diverted. Hence, no such records of all consultations and meetings of the Forest Right Committee(s) Gram Sabha(s), Sub-Division Level Committee(s) and the District Level Committee are enclosed.

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- (b) Additional Deputy Commissioner, Billaوار vide his office letter No. ADC/Blr/2022-23/1600-03 dated 26/08/2022 reported that there is no pendency of any FRA claim in the Revenue village viz Machhedi, Badnota, Thall, Malhar & Malad falling in the project area.
- (c) Sub Divisional Magistrate, Bani vide his office letter No. SDM/B/2022-23/288 dated 27-09-2022 submitted that no forest right claim is pending in Patwar Halquas Duggan, Dullangal and Dhagger of Tehsil Bani.

Hence, Forest Rights Act certificate is issued for forest land measuring 0.97 Ha. required for laying of Optical Fiber Cable on Forest Division Billaوار, in District Kathua.

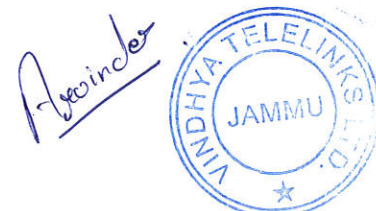
