The subject to project is construction of road from **Patnazi to Kither** having a length of 15.58 Kms. The project emerges diversion of 2.895 hac. of forest land for construction of road in district Kishtwar UT of J&K (online proposal no FP/JK/ROAD/118616/2020) for which the principal approval is sought vide file no.9-JKB-023/2021 Jammu dtd. 18/05/2021 subject to condition mentioned below whose compliance has been completed on part of indenting agency i.e PMGSY division Kishtwar and same has been detailed para wise below.

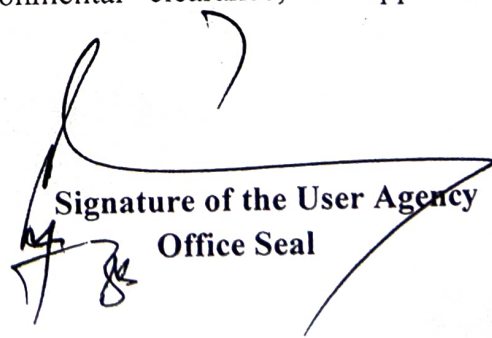

UNDERTAKING

I, Er. Mohinder Kumar, Executive Engineer PMGSY Division Kishtwar having applied for diversion of forest land for above mentioned road do hereby undertake the following points:-

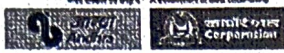
- i) That the legal status of the forest land will remain unchanged;
- ii) That efforts shall be made to fell minimum number of trees and in any case, not more than 422 Trees/poles (186 trees+236 U/s Poles) will be felled.
- iii) That the acquired dumping sites shall be prepared appropriately before start of dumping to prevent downhill slide of muck;
- iv) That the angle of repose of muck shall be maintained between 30 degree to 40 degree;
- v) That long slope shall be intercepted to several short ones with help of berms/ terraces/ benches;
- vi) That the dumping sites which will attain full capacity shall be rehabilitated with local grass, trees and shrubs;
- vii) That the forest land will not be used for any other purpose than that mentioned in the proposal;
- viii) That the forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agency, department, or person without approval of the Central Government;
- ix) That the layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without the prior approval of the Central Government.
- x) That no damage will be done to the adjoining forest land;
- xi) That no labour camp shall be established on the forest land;
- xii) That the user agency shall pay additional amount of NPV as and when increased on the order of Hon'ble Supreme Court;
- xiii) That the User Agency shall provide firewood preferably alternate fuels to the labourers and the staff working at the site so as to avoid any damage and pressure on the nearby forest areas;
- xiv) That any other condition that the Regional Office may stipulate, from time to time, in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife shall be abided;
- xv) That it will be the responsibility of the State Government/User Agency to obtain all other prior approvals/clearances under all other relevant Acts/Rules/Court's Rulings/instructions, etc., including environmental clearance, as applicable to this proposal.
