
On the subject matter cited above, compliance report of the terms and conditions laid down in the above-referred *In-Principle* approval letter for diversion of forest land under the Forest Conservation Act, 1980 is submitted as under:-

	Conditions	Compliance by user/indenting agency, PMGSY Division, Jammu
A.	Conditions which need to be complied prior to handing over of forest land by the J&K Forest Department.	
1.	Cost of compensatory afforestation as per CA schemes may be realized from the user agency.	As per the demand note issued by the Divisional Forest Officer, Samba. vide No. DFO/SFD/4667-70 Dated: 04-12-2025 an amount of Rs. 8,80,380.00 Net Present Value (NPV) and Rs.4,98,000 compensatory afforestation (CA) have been deposited through web portal of Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change www.parivesh.nic.in (Copy of online receipt is enclosed)
2.	Net Present Value (NPV) of the forest land being diverted for non-forestry purpose may be fully realized from the user agency, as per MoEF & CC directions issued vide letter no. 5-3/2007-FC dated-05.02.2009 and the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India's orders dated-30.10.2002, 28.03.2008,24.04.2008 and 09.05.2008 and as per the Guidelines issued by the Ministry vide letter no. 5-3/2014-FC Vol. 1 dated-06.01.2022.	
3.	User agency should ensure that the compensatory levies (CA cost, NPV, etc.) are deposited through challan generated online on web portal and deposited in appropriate bank only. Amount deposited through other mode will not be accepted as compliance of the Stage-I clearance.	Agreed and complied.

4.	As per the orders of Government of India vide letter no. 5-2/2010/Campa dated-24.06.2011. The net present value (NPV) of the forest land and all the other CA levies shall be deposited through the web portal of Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change www.parivesh.nic.in	Agreed and complied
5.	The complete compliance of the FRA, 2006 shall be ensured by way of prescribed certificate from the concerned District Collector.	FRA Certificate issued by the Deputy Commissioner, is enclosed.
6.	The UT of J&K shall not issue temporary working permission until the entire compensatory levies are deposited by User Agency and confirmed online on Ministry's web portal.	Agreed and complied with
7.	Divisional Forest Officer furnish undertaking that the approved CA site(s) will not be changed without the approval of competent authority.	Pertains to forest department
8.	The CEO, State CAMPA Authority shall furnish undertaking that the funds under UT CAMPA will be released to Divisional Forest Officer as per approved CA schemes.	Pertains to forest department
9.	Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Forest Conservation Act, 1980 and action will be taken as prescribed in Para 1.21 of Chapter 1 of the Handbook of Guidelines of Forest(Conservation) Act, 1980 as issued by this Ministry's letter no 5-2/2017-FC dated 28/03/2019.	Agreed and complied.
B	Conditions which need to be strictly complied on field after handing over the forest land to the user agency by the J&K Forest Department but the compliance undertaking shall be submitted prior to stage-II approval.	
1.	Legal status of forest will remain unchanged.	Agreed and complied.
2.	No trees shall be felled in this proposal.	Agreed and complied.
3.	No muck will be dumped in the forest land in context of undertaking given by UA of using muck on road itself.	Agreed and complied.
4.	The DFO shall ensure that User agency shall not dump muck outside the road in forest area as per the muck disposal certificate furnished by the user agency.	Pertains to forest department
5.	The forest land shall not be used for any other purpose than that specified in the project proposal.	Agreed and complied.
6.	No damage will be done to the adjoining forest land. Simultaneously, all efforts will be made to save adjoining forest and forest land.	Agreed and complied.
7.	The user agency shall pay additional amount of NPV as and when increased on the order of Hon'ble Supreme Court and the UT Government will ensure that the	Agreed and complied.

	increased amount is deposited.	
8.	The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agency, department, or person without approval of the Central Government.	Agreed and complied.
9.	The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of Central Government.	Agreed and complied.
10.	No labour camp shall be established inside the forest area.	Agreed and complied.
11.	The User Agency shall provide firewood preferably alternate fuels to the labourers and the staff working at the site so as to avoid any damage and pressure on the nearby forest areas.	Agreed and complied.
12.	Any other condition that this Regional office may stipulate, from time to time, in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife.	Agreed and complied.
13.	It will be the responsibility of State Government / user agency to obtain all the other prior approvals / clearances under all other relevant acts / rules/ court's rulings / instructions etc. including environmental clearance as applicable to this proposal.	Agreed and complied.
