Apropos to the above captioned subject, it is to submit that in continuation to this office correspondences regarding forest clearance of the subject road, wherein all the requisite formalities for award of Forest Clearance/Stage-II Approval have been completed by this office. Now, the compliance report of all the conditions as laid down in In-Principal Approval pertaining to User Agency/this office is submitted here under for information and further course of necessary action at your end please.

Part-A Conditions which need to be complied prior to handing over of forest land by the State Forest Department.

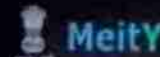

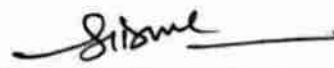
