On the subject matter cited above, compliance report of the terms and conditions laid down in the in-principal approval issued by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change vide File No. File No. 9-JKA-065/2021-Jammu dated 24-08-2021 for diversion of 0.225 Ha. of forest land under Forest Conservation Act, 1980 is submitted as under:

A. Conditions which need to be complied prior to handing over of forest land by the State Forest Department.

**Undertaking**

It is to certify that I Executive Engineer, PMGSY Division, Udhampur have applied for diversion of **0.225 ha** of forest land for the purpose of "**Construction of road from Barkunda to Kharwa (Online proposal No. FP/JK/ROAD/138546/2021)**" I hereby undertake to comply the following conditions:

- i) Legal status of the forest land will remain unchanged;
- ii) Efforts should be made to fell minimum number of trees and in any case, not more than 61 Trees & 37 U/s Poles will be felled.
- iii) The UT Govt shall upload the KML files of the degraded forest area accepted for raising compensatory afforestation in the E-Green watch portal of FSI, before handing over of forest land to the user agency
- iv) No muck will be dumped in the forest land as the muck dumping sites have been identified non-forest land;
- v) The DFO shall ensure that User agency shall not dump muck on forest land;
- vi) The forest land will not be used for any other purpose than that mentioned in the proposal;
- vii) The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agency, department, or person without approval of the Central Government;
- viii) The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without the prior approval of the Central Government;
- ix) The user agency shall raise strip plantation on both sides and central verge of the road at the project cost as per IRC specifications with maintenance of seven to ten years;
- x) No damage will be done to the adjoining forest land;
- xi) No labour camp shall be established on the forest land;
- xii) The user agency shall pay additional amount of NPV as and when increased on the order of Hon'ble Supreme Court;
- xiii) The User Agency shall provide firewood preferably alternate fuels to the labourers and the staff working at the site so as to avoid any damage and pressure on the nearby forest areas;
- xiv) Any other condition that this Regional Office may stipulate, from time to time, in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife;
- xv) It will be the responsibility of the State Government/User Agency to obtain all other prior approvals/clearances under all other relevant Acts/Rules/Court's Rulings/instructions. etc., including environmental clearance, as applicable to this proposal.

3. After receipt of the compliance report on fulfillment of the condition under para-2, above, final approval order shall be given under Section-2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. The use of Forest land will not be allowed till final approval is accorded.

**Subject: Issuance of Forest Right Act (FRA) Certificate for construction of PMGSY road "Barkunda to Kharwa" under Package No. JK14-507, Block Chenani.**

In compliance with the Ministry of Environment and Forest (MoEF) Government of India's letter No. 11-9/98-Fc (pt) dated 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Right) Act, 2006 (FRA, for short) on the Forest land proposed to be diverted for Non Forest purposes read with MoEF's letter dated 5<sup>th</sup> January 2013 wherein MoEF issued certain exemption/relaxation in respect of Linear Projects, it is certified that 0.225 hectares of Forest land is of PMGSY Division Udhampu-I, Udhampur in Tehsil Chenani & District Udhampur. The detail of the road/project id detailed below:

It is further certified that:

The complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 0.225 hectares of forest area proposed for diversion. As per MoEF letter No. F. No. 11-9/98-FC(9pt) dated 5<sup>th</sup> Feb. 2013 for liner projects like constructions of roads, canals, laying of pipelines/optical fibre and transmission lines etc., there is no requirement of resolution /meeting /consent of Gram Sabha of said area for forest land use of which is proposed to be diverted. Hence, no such records of all the Forest Rights Committee(s) Gram Sabha (s). Sub-Division Level Committee(s) and the District Level Committee are enclosed.

Tehsildar Chenani vide his office letter No. 506/OQ dated 19-07-2021 submitted that no recognized rights of Primitive Tribal Groups (PTG) and Pre Agriculture Committees (PAC) shall be affected in diversion of forest land for non forest use which is required for construction of above mentioned PMGSY road project in PMGSY Division Udhampur-I, Udhampur.

Hence, Forest Rights Act certificate is issued for forest land measuring 0.225 Hectares required for above mentioned PMGSY road in PMGSY Division Udhampur-I, Udhampur.
