On the subject matter cited above, compliance report of the terms and conditions laid down in the In-principle approval (Stage-1 approval) accorded by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Govt. of India vide File No.9-JKB-43/2021-Jammu dated 19-05-2021 for diversion of **0.525 Ha.** of forest land under **Forest Conservation Act, 1980** is submitted as under:

| iv) | User agency should ensure that the compensatory levies (CA cost, NPV, etc.) are deposited through challan generated online on web portal and deposited in appropriate bank only. Amount deposited through other mode will not be accepted as compliance of the Stage-I clearance | |
| v) | The UT of J&K shall not issue temporary working permission until entire compensatory levies are deposited by the User Agency and confirmed online on Ministry's web portal | |

Undertaking

It is to certify that I Executive Engineer, PMGSY Division, Ramnagar have applied for diversion of 0.525 of forest land for the purpose of “**Construction of road from Larey To Sumal, District Udhampur UT of Jammu and Kashmir**” (Online proposal no. **FP/JK/ROAD/141991/2021**). I hereby undertake to comply the following conditions:

- i) Legal status of the forest land will remain unchanged;
- ii) Efforts will be made to fell minimum number of trees and in any case, not more than 0 Trees and 7 u/s Poles;
- iii) No muck will be dumped on the forest land. Muck dumping will be strictly restricted to the designated muck dumping sites outside forest area.
- iv) Muck dumping will be disposed off on the designated dumping site.
- v) The forest land will not be used for any other purpose than that mentioned in the proposal;
- vi) The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agency, department, or person without approval of the Central Government;
- vii) The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without the prior approval of the Central Government.
- viii) No damage will be done to the adjoining forest land;
- ix) No labour camp shall be established on the forest land;
- x) The user agency shall pay additional amount of NPV as and when increased on the order of Hon’ble Supreme Court;
- xi) The User Agency shall provide firewood preferably alternate fuels to the labourers and the staff working at the site so as to avoid any damage and pressure on the nearby forest areas;
- xii) Any other condition that this Regional Office may stipulate, from time to time, in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife;
- xiii) It will be the responsibility of the State Government/User Agency to obtain all other prior approvals/clearances under all other relevant Acts/Rules/ Court’s Rulings/instructions, etc., including environmental clearance, as applicable to this proposal.
- xiv) After receipt of the compliance report on fulfillment of the conditions under para-2, above, final approval order shall be given under Section-2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. The use of forestland will not be allowed till final approval is accorded.


