Sub: Issuance of Forest Right Act certificate (FRA) for the diversion of forest land required for construction of additional length of 1.50 KM of road from Angralla to Gulabgarh, Package No.JK14-727, Stage I, Phase XII under PMGSY Division Mahore, District Reasi.

In reference to letter No.11-9/98-FC (pt) dated 3rd August 2009 of Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India's wherein guidelines on submission of evidences have been issued for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 ('FRA', for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes read with MoEF's letter dated 5th February 2013 wherein MoEF issued certain exemption/relaxation in respect of linear projects, it is certified that:

- (a) The forest land is proposed to be diverted in favour of Construction of additional length of 1.50 KM of road from Angralla to Gulabgarh, Package No.JK14-727, Stage I, Phase XII under PMGSY Division Mahore, District Reasi.
- (b) Tehsildar Mahore vide No.40/OQ dated 03-05-2023 has communicated that No recognized rights of Primitive Tribal Groups (PTG) and Pre Agricultural Communities (PAC) shall be affected in diversion of forest land for non forest use for construction of additional length of 1.50 KM of road from Angralla to Gulabgarh, Package No.JK14-727, Stage I, Phase XII under PMGSY Division Mahore, District Reasi.

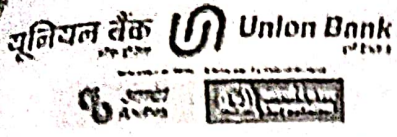

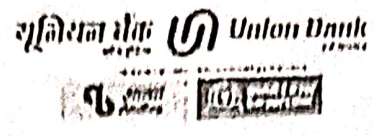
