With reference to the above cited subject, it is submitted that the In- principle approval for diversion of 0.4178 ha of forest land for construction of link road from Panditgam to Chanseri under R&B Department Jammu, Doda Forest Division, District Doda, U.T of Jammu & Kashmir (Online proposal No. FP/JK/Road/45122/2020) has been accorded vide Regional Officer, IRO, MoEF&CC, Jammu's file No. 9-JKA-087/2021-Jammu Dated: 01/03/2023. 

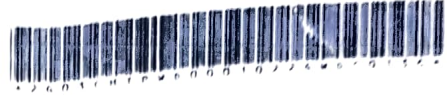
