With reference to the above cited subject and reference, it is submitted that the proposal for diversion of 0.03 Ha of forest land construction of Parmaz Link Road in Doda Forest Division and District Doda UT of Jammu and Kashmir has been accorded the In-principle approval vide Under secretary to Govt. Forest ecology and environment department civil secretariat J&K Jammu's No. FST/Land/Parivesh/32/2020 dated 17-02-2021 subject to conditions mentioned below whose compliance has been completed an part of user agency i.e PWD (R&B) Division Doda and same has been detailed para wise below:




UNDERTAKING FOR COMPLIANCE TO BE SUBMITTED PRIOR TO STAGE-II
