

Please refer to the above cited subject and letters seeking prior approval of the Central Government for diversion of 0.815 ha forest land for non-forestry purpose in accordance with section 2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.

2. After careful examination of the proposal of the UT Administration of J&K, *in-principle* approval is hereby conveyed for diversion 0.815 ha of forest land for the above mentioned project, subject to the following conditions:

(A) Conditions which need to be complied prior to handing over of forest land by the State Forest Department.

- i) Cost of compensatory afforestation as per CA scheme may be realized from the user agency.


