With reference to the above cited subject and reference, it is submitted that the proposal for diversion of 2.94 Ha has been accorded the In-principle approval vide No:- File no. 9-JKB-062/2021- Jammu Dated 16-09-2021 subject to conditions mentioned below whose compliance has been completed on part of user agency i.e. PWD (R&B) Division Bhaderwah and same has been detailed para wise below:




ANNEXURE -B**"UNDERTAKING FOR COMPLIANCE TO BE SUBMITTED PRIOR TO STAGE-II APPROVAL"**

I on behalf of PWD (R&B) Division Bharderwah in respect to proposal for diversion of 2.94 Ha of Forest Land for Construction of road from Dhamunda More to Jai via Manthla Kakol in Bharderwah Forest Division is hereby Undertake to Comply the below mentioned conditions.

1. Legal Status of the forest land shall remain unchanged.
2. Efforts should be made to fell minimum number of trees(237 trees & 60 U/s Poles). The trees shall be felled under the strict supervision of the UT Forest Department and the cost of felling of trees shall be deposited by the User Agency with UT Forest Department/J&K FDC as applicable.
3. UT Government shall upload the KML files of degraded forest area accepted for raising compensatory afforestation in the E-Green watch portal of FSI, before handing over forest land to the user agency.
4. No muck will be dumped in the forest land.
5. No muck will be dumped in the forest area.
6. The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the project proposal.
7. The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agencies, department or person without approval of Central Government;
8. The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without the prior approval of Central Government.
9. The user agency shall raise strip plantation on both sides and central verge of the road at the project cost as per IRC specification with maintenance of 07-10 years.
10. No damage will be done to the adjoining forest land.
11. No labour camp shall be established on the forest land.
12. The user agency shall pay additional amount of NPV as and when increased on the order of Hon'ble Supreme Court.
13. The user agency shall provide firewood preferably alternate fuels to the labourers and the staff working at the site so as to avoid any damage and pressure on the nearby forest areas.

14. Any other condition that this Regional Office may stipulate, from time to time, in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife.
15. It will be the responsibility of the UT Government/User Agency to obtain all other prior approvals/clearances under all other relevant Acts/Rules/Court's Rulings/instructions, etc., including environmental clearance, as applicable to this proposal.


