TERMS & CONDITIONS: -

(A) Conditions which need to be complied prior to handing over of forest land by the J&K Forest Department.

(B) Conditions which need to be strictly complied on field after handing over of forest land to the user agency by the J&K Forest Department but the compliance in form of undertaking shall be submitted prior to Stage-II approval.



In compliance of the Rule 6(3)(e) of the Forest (Conservation) Rules, 2003 as amended vide the Forest (Conservation) Amendment Rules 2014, Forest (Conservation) second Amendment Rules 2014, and Forest (Conservation) Amendment Rules 2016, it is certified that 3.67 Ha of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of **PMGSY(JKRRDA) Division, Bandipora** for the construction of road from **Neeru to Sikander** falls within the jurisdiction of Tehsil Tulail, District Bandipora for which Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Integrated Regional Office, Jammu vide letter No. 9-JKB011/2021-Jammu, dated:19/04/2021 has accorded the In-Principal Approval.
