v)	The UT of J&K shall not issue temporary working permission until entire compensatory levies are deposited by the User Agency and confirmed online on Ministry's web portal.	Pertains to UT of J&K
vi)	Violation of any these conditions will amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and action will be taken as prescribed in Para 1.21 of Chapter 1 of the Handbook of Guidelines of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 as issued by this Ministry's letter no 5-2/2017-FC dated 28/03/2019. vii)	Divisional Forest Officer shall furnish undertaking that the approved CA site(s) will not be changed without the approval of competent authority.	N/A
viii)	CEO State CAMPA shall furnish undertaking that the funds under state/UT CAMPA will be released to Divisional Forest Officer as per approved CA Scheme.	N/A
ix)	FRA Certificate from competent Authority to be submitted	Agreed

ii)	Efforts should be made to fell minimum number of trees and in any case, not more than 95 Trees & 30 U/s Poles will be felled.	Agreed
iii)	The UT Govt shall upload the KML files of the degraded forest area accepted for raising compensatory afforestation in the E-Green watch portal of FSI, before handing over of forest land to the user agency.	N/A
iv)	No muck will be dumped in the forest land as the muck dumping sites have been identified on non-forest land.	Agreed & Complied
v)	The DFO shall ensure that User agency shall not dump muck on forest land.	Agreed & Complied
vi)	The forest land will not be used for any other purpose than that mentioned in the proposal.	Agreed & Complied
vii)	The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agency, department, or person without approval of the Central Government.	Agreed & Complied
viii)	The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without the prior approval of the Central Government.	Agreed
ix)	The user agency shall raise strip plantation on both sides and central verge of the road at the project cost as per IRC specifications with maintenance of seven to ten years.	Agreed
x)	No damage will be done to the adjoining forest land.	Agreed
xi)	No labour camp shall be established on the forest land.	Agreed
xii)	The user Agency shall pay additional amount of NPV as and when increased on the order of Hon'ble Supreme Court.	Agreed
xiii)	The user Agency shall provide firewood preferably alternate fuels to the labourers and the staff working at the site so as to avoid any damage and pressure on the nearby forest areas.	Agreed & Complied
xiv)	Any other condition that this Regional Office may stipulate, from time to time, in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife.	Agreed
xv)	It will be the responsibility of the State Government/User Agency to obtain all other prior approvals/clearances under all other relevant Acts/Rules/Court's Rulings/Instructions, etc., including environmental clearance, as applicable to this proposal.	Agreed
