**Sub: Diversion of 2.2425 hac. forest land for construction of New Govt. Degree College Dudu Basantgarh distt.Udhampur UT of Jammu and Kashmir-Compliance report**

Respected Sir,

On the subject matter cited above compliance report of the terms and conditions laid down in the letter no.DFO/Rgr/FCA/6846-48 dated 17/01/2023 for the diversion of 2.2425 hac. of forest land under Forest Conservation Act, 1980 is submitted as under:

i.	Legal status of the forest land will remain unchanged.	Agreed
ii.	Cost of compensatory afforestation as per scheme may be realized from the user agency. The CA will be maintained for 10 years.	As per demand note issued by DFO Ramnagar vide no. DFO/Rgr/FCA/453-58 dated 29-04-2024, an amount of Rs 3082196/- for compensatory afforestation has been deposited through the challan generated online on web portal and deposited in the appropriate bank account.
iii.	The state government shall charge the Net Present Value (NPV) of the forest land being diverted for non-forestry purpose from the user agency, as per orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 30.10.2002, 01.08.2003, 28.03.2008, 24.04.2008 and 09.05.2008 in IA No. 566 in WP (C) No. 202/1995 and as per the guidelines issued by the Ministry vide letter No. 5-3/2011-FC (Vol-I) dated 6th January, 2022 in this regard.	As per demand note issued by DFO Ramnagar vide no. DFO/Rgr/FCA/453-58 dated 29-04-2024, an amount of Rs 3082196/- for compensatory afforestation has been deposited through the challan generated online on web portal and deposited in the appropriate bank account.
iv.	User agency shall deposit/transfer all the funds (cost of CA, NPV, etc) to CAMPA fund of the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change through e Portal( <a href="https://parivesh.nic.in">https://parivesh.nic.in</a> ).	All the dues as per demand note deposited in the JK Campa fund
v.	User agency should ensure that the compensatory levies (CA cost, NPV, etc) are deposited through challan generated online through web portal and deposited in appropriate bank only. Amount deposited through other mode will not be accepted as compliance of stage-1 clearance;	Amount deposited as per standing guidelines.
vi.	The complete compliance of FRA, 2006 shall be ensured by way of prescribed certificate from the concerned District Collector.	Already uploaded
vii.	Divisional Forest Officer, Ramnagar Forest Division shall furnish undertaking that the approved CA sites will not be changed without the approval of the Competent Authority.	Pertains to forest department

**UNDERTAKING**

It is to certify that I, Principal, GDC Dudu Basantgarh have applied for diversion of 2.2425 ha of forest land for the construction of college building for Govt. Degree College Dudu Basantgarh. I hereby undertake to comply the following conditions as mentioned in point "B" in stage I approval:

S. No.	Terms and conditions laid down in the Govt. file no. 9-JKB-001/2023-Jammu dated January 2023
i.	Efforts should be made to fell minimum number of trees and in any case not more than 26 trees only shall be felled. Any felling shall only be done under strict supervision of State Forest Department after issuance of felling permission from concerned DFO and the cost of felling of trees shall be deposited by the User Agency with the State Forest Department.
ii.	The UT Govt. shall upload the KML filed of degraded forest area accepted for raising compensatory afforestation as well as the forest area proposed for diversion in the extant proposal in the E-Green watch portal of Forest Survey of India.
iii.	Compensatory afforestation will be carried out over degraded forest area (DFL) upon 4.9335 ha of land in Raichak, Comp no 28/bgh (D-K Selection working circle), Range-Basantgarh, Ramnagar Forest Division, District-Udhampur, as per proposed CA scheme at a cost of Rs.6,83,910/- (Rupees Six Lacs eighty-three thousand nine hundred ten only) provided by user agency.
iv.	The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of Central Government.
v.	The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the project proposal.
vi.	The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agency, department, or person without approval of Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change.
vii.	No labour camp shall be established on the forest land.
viii.	Sufficient firewood, preferably by the alternate fuel shall be provided by User Agency to the labourer after purchasing the same from the State Forest Department or the Forest Development Corporation or any other legal source of alternate fuel.
ix.	The boundary of the diverted forest land shall be suitably demarcated on ground at the project cost, as per the directions of the concerned Divisional Forest Officer.
x.	No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for the transportation of construction materials for execution of project work.
xi.	The User agency shall pay additional amount of NPV as and when increased by the orders of Hon'ble Supreme court.
xii.	The User agency shall obtain Environmental Clearance as per the provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, if applicable.
xiii.	No muck shall be dumped in the forest land in context of the undertaking given by User Agency.
xiv.	The User Agency shall raise strip plantation on both sides and central verge of the road as per IRC norms.
xv.	Speed regulating signage will be erected along the road at regular intervals in the Forest Areas.
xvi.	Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and action would be taken as per provisions under 1.21 of the Handbook of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 and Forest Conservation Rules, 2003 (Guidelines & Clarification), 2019, MoEF&CC.
xvii.	Any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change may stipulate from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests and wildlife.
xviii.	The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change may revoke/suspend the clearance, if implementation of any of the above conditions is not satisfactory. The State Government will ensure compliance of these conditions through Forest Department.

In compliance of the Rule 6(3)(e) of the Forest (Conservation) Rules, 2003 [as amended vide the Forest (Conservation) Amendment Rules 2014; Forest (Conservation) second Amendment Rules 2014; and Forest (Conservation) second Amendment Rules 2016, it is certified that 2.245 hectares of state land (kind of soil of which is Gair Mumkin Jar) is proposed to be diverted in favour of Principal, Govt. Degree College, Basantgarh for construction of New Govt. building for Degree College Dudu Basantgarh, Tehsil Latti Marothi in Udhampur district falls within jurisdiction of village **Pachound** in Tehsil **Latti Marothi**. It is further certified that:

- (a) The complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 2.245 hectares of state land (kind of soil of which is Gair Mumkin Jar) proposed for diversion. There is no requirement of resolution of the Gram Sabha of the area as the land under diversion is state land, not forest land only kind of soil is Gair Mumkin Jar;
- (b) The proposal does not involve recognized right of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-agricultural communities as reported by Tehsildar, Latti Marothi vide No. TLM/OQ/2021-22/999 dated 12.03.2022.
