
In exercise of the power vested in me under rule 6(3)(e) of the Forest (Conservation) Rules, 2003 (with its amendments *mutatis mutandi* in the years 2014 & 2016) and on the basis of reports obtained from the Assistant Commissioner Panchayat Ramban vide No: ACP/RBN/2024-25/360-62 dated 27.05.2024, it is certified that **1.47** hectares of forest land in the district proposed to be diverted for **re-alignment of 220 KV D/C KPTL at loc. 
On the subject matter cited above, compliance report of the terms and conditions laid down in the in-principle approval issued by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change vide **File No. 9-JKB-003/2020-Jammu dated 29-04-2022** for diversion of 1.47 Ha of forest land under Forest Conservation Act, 1980 is submitted as under:

A. Conditions which need to be complied prior to handing over of forest land by the State Forest Department.

i)	Legal status of forest land will remain unchanged	Agreed and complied with

iii)	The state Government shall charge the Net Present Value (NPV) of the forest land being diverted for non-forestry purpose from the user agency as per orders of the Hon ble Supreme Court of India dated 30th October 2002, 1 st August 2003, 28th March 2008, 24th April, 2008 and 9th May 2008 in IA NO. 566 in WP@ NO. 202/1995 and as per the guidelines issued by the Ministry vide lettes No. 5-3/2011-FC Vol-1 dated 6th January 2022 in this regard.
