
Compliance report of diversion of 7.414 ha of forest land for upgradation of 9.93km of existing 66kV Attingal-Palode SC feeder to 110kV double circuit from Mithirmala to Palode

Vide In-principle approval /Stage-I clearance F No. 4-KLC1436/2023-BAN dtd. 10.07.2023 of the Central Government under Section '2' of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.

1	The user agency shall transfer online, the Net Present Value of the forest land being diverted under this proposal, as per the guideline issued by Ministry vide letter No.5-3/2011-FC (Vol-1) dated 06.01.2022. The requisite funds shall be transferred through online portal into CAMPA account of the State concerned.	The demanded amount of NPV has been transferred through online portal into Kerala State CAMPA account. (Rs 1,06,51,471.38/- RTGS UTR No. SBINR52024071936566878)
2	The User Agency shall transfer the cost of raising Compensatory Afforestation over 15 ha. of degraded forest land at Ananthan Estate of Kallar Section, Palode Range, Thiruvananthapuram division at the current wage rate in consultation with the State Forest Department in the account of CAMPA of the concerned State through online portal. The scheme may include demarcation of degraded forest land using appropriate fencing with provision for anticipated cost of increase for working scheduled for subsequent years. The CA will be maintained for 10 years.	The demanded amount of Compensatory Afforestation has been transferred through online portal into Kerala State CAMPA account. (Rs 27,80,000/- RTGS UTR No. SBINR52024071936566878)
3	The KML file of the area diverted and CA area shall be uploaded in the e-green watch portal with all requisite details and same shall be submitted along with GPS Id.	The KML file has been uploaded.
4	The State government shall complete the settlement of rights, in terms of the Scheduled Tribes and other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act 2006, if any, on the forest land to be diverted and submit the documentary evidence as prescribed by this Ministry in its letter No. 11-9/1998-FC dated 3 rd August 2009 read with 05.07.2013 with necessary enclosures, in support thereof.	The FRA certificate obtained and has been uploaded.

5	All the funds received from the user agency under the project shall be transferred/deposited in CAMPA account only through e-portal (https://parivesh.nic.in/). Amount deposited through other mode will not be accepted as compliance of the stage-I clearance.	Amount deposited in CAMPA account through online mode. Copy of RTGS slip showing transaction details attached.
6	The boundary of the forest land to be diverted shall be suitably demarcated on ground at the project cost as per the directions of concerned Divisional Forest Officer before Stage-II approval.	Complied as per the directions of Divisional Forest Officer, Thiruvananthapuram.
7	The compliance report shall be uploaded on e-portal (https://parivesh.nic.in/).	The compliance report has been submitted.
8	Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and action would be taken as prescribed in para 1.21 of chapter 1 of the Handbook of comprehensive guidelines of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 as issued by this Ministry's letter No. 5-2/2017-FC dated 28.03.2019.	All the conditions are complied, no violations made.
