ii. Compensatory afforestation a. Compensatory afforestation shall be taken up by the Forest Department over 9.33 ha non forest land in Survey/ Gut. No. 60 at Village- Baslapur, Taluka- Chandur Railway, District- Amravati at the cost of the User Agency. As far as possible, a mixture of local indigenous species along with 10% RET species of Amravati District shall be planted and monoculture of any species may be avoided. At least two water bodies shall be constructed in the form of tank/ stop dams etc if the same are not available in the area or in nearby vicinity; ii b. The non-forest land proposed for CA shall be transferred and mutated in the name of Forest Department and notified as RF/PF prior to Stage-II approval. A copy of the original notification declaring the non-forest land under Section 4 or Section 29 of the Indian Forest Act, 1927, or under the relevant section of the State Forest Act as the case may be, will be submitted by the State Government prior to Stage II approval	Compensatory afforestation shall be taken up after final approval. The non-forest land proposed for CA is transferred and mutated in the name of Forest Department. Possession receipt & 7/12 extract of said land is attached as Annexure- 2. 2.
