Introduction

- MUMBAI RAILWAY VIKAS CORPORATION LTD (MRVC), having its corporate office at 2nd Floor Churchgate Station Building, Churchgate, Mumbai- 400020, India is a Public Sector undertaking of Government of India under Ministry of Railways (MOR) incorporated under companies Act 1956.
- MUTP III was included in the budget of 2015-2016 and it includes double line corridor between Panvel Karjat Section (29.60 km) on Central Railway. The Union Cabinet chaired by the Prime Minister has approved MUTP phase III on 30.11.2016.

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The Mumbai suburban railway network on the Central Railway has two corridors — i) Main line and ii) Harbour line. The Main line corridor connects Chhatrapati Shivaji Terminus (CSTM) with Kalyan. The Harbour line corridor starts at CSTM and terminates at Panvel.

The Navi Mumbai area, especially around Panvel, has witnessed significant urbanization and population growth in recent years. The area between Panvel and Karjat is also developing rapidly and hence there is increasing demand for extending the suburban train services to Karjat. Currently, a single line 29.60 km track connects Panvel with Karjat. It caters only to goods and a few long distance passenger trains. Mumbai Rail Vikas Corporation (MRVC) plans to increase network capacity and improve customer services on this corridor. MRVC has therefore commissioned the services of Omega Analytics to undertake a feasibility study for constructing an additional line between Panvel to Karjat. In view of this, about 9.13.21 Hector of Forest land is required to be diverted for Doubling Railway Line of this railway having length of 29.60 Km. Which passes through 8 forest villages Belavali, Bhingar, Barvai, Bherale Tal. Panvel, Lodhivali, Vavarle, Tal Khalapur and Kiravali, Vanjale, Tal Karjat, Raigad District.

Factual Position of Construction at site

- the above mentioned forest land. Mostly Tunnel is through about 3.3. km length (3 nos. Tunnel) where passing through is required for Govt and private forest.
- Out of 9.1321 hectare the physical execution of work only in between 4.908 hectare and remaining forest land i.e. 4.2241 hectare only permission taken where where Tunnel passing below forest land and in that portion of no deforesting or any disturbance to forest land and there will be free space for passage of mens and Animals etc and does not breaking any movement path of animals.

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The following discussion regarding before stage clearance I,

Integrated Regional office/ Nagpur, Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change of Govt. of India had placed the proposal before Regional Empowered Committee (REC) in its meeting held on 16.09.2021.

- 3. MOEF & CC Observations- For detailed examination of proposal comments from PCCF (HoFF)/PCCF (Wildlife), Maharashtra and District Collector, Raigad on any adverse impact of proposal on local Biodiversity /Wildlife/Environment and Mitigation measures therefor needs to be submitted.
- 4. The details justification for proposed detailed examination on any adverse impact of proposal on local Biodiversity /Wildlife/Environment and Mitigation measures therefor needs is as under.
- a. The proposed Panvel-Karjat suburban corridor (Double railway line) in Raigad District is beyond 7.46 kms (i.e. 11.1 km) of the boundary of the protected area (Sanctuary and National park) Karnal Bird sanctuary- hence need not be affected on local Biodiversity
- b. The distance of nearest Tansa wild life Sanctuary is 66 km from Proposed forest land detail shown from Tansa wild life Sanctuary is shown on Google map and KMZ file details.





Hence It is seen from the both that, there will not been any adverse impact on local Biodiversity/Wildlife/Environment as the distance is more than 7.46 km and in this project it is about 66 km.

5. Site Inspection, Discussion and Recommendation-

The joint forest site inspection was done on 08.03.2022 vide DCF Alibag Raigad's letter no. व /२०/बमीन /व सं /४९६१/२०२१-२२ दिनांक ०७.०३.२०२२ at forest land site.

Ajoint forest site was done on 08.03.2022 along with Deputy conservator of Forest Alibag, Deputy conservator of Forest (wildlife) Thane, concerned RFO and Railway officials.

During site inspection concerned RFO based on his field experience and his office record stated that, the proposed forest land is adjacent to the human habitation and agriculture land and presence of wild animal is not there. Also, incidences of human wildlife conflict are also Nil in the prosed forest land. It was revealed in Joint site Inspection that mitigation measures are not feasible as prosed forest areas for diversion is scattered and in many small patches and absence of wildlife therein.

Considering the facts and discussion during site inspection with forest officials and as per letter DCF (wildlife) Thane's letter no. जमीन /१४८४/2021-22 dated 14.03.2022, it is recommended following.

- a. To erect chain-link fencing of 8 m height and 100 m length along both sides of the Railway line at both ends of the tunnel (i.e. before starting point and after the end of point of Tunnels) with annual maintenance to avoid entry of any wild animal in the tunnel.
- b. To install necessary signage/direction boards depicting messages about wildlife conservation and helpline/contact of forest and railway officials to make people

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and to tackle situation of human wildlife confict, if any in the future.

The joint site visit for forest land has been carried out on 8.03.2022 alongwith DCF Alibag, and DCF Wild life Thane. The discussion has been held at site regarding the Wild life. Accordingly DCF (Wild life) Thane vide his letter no. जमीन /1484 /2021-22 dated. 14.03.2022. The details are as under,

As per recommendation of DCF wild life during his site inspection 14.03.2022. has decided, to erect chain -link fencing of 8m height and 100m length along both sides of the railway line at both the ends of the tunnels (i.e. before starting point and after the end point of the tunnels) with annual maintenance to avoid entry of any wild animal in the tunnel. It is also recommended to install necessary signage/direction boards depicting messages about wildlife conservation and helpline/contact of forest and railway officials to make people aware about wildlife conservation and to tackle situation of human wildlife conflict, if any in the future. And his mitigation is sufficient for these site specific location

Also as a specific measures for 10 years wild life management plan , the following extra provisions are required as a mitigation measures for future.

The following mitigation measures are to be provided by user agency,

- 1. The forest area is 11.1 km away from Karnala bird sanctuary century and 66 km from Tansa wild life sanctuary hence does not affet on local biodiversity. But as a mitigation measures, user agency will provide 25 number CUDDE Back digital brand to capture the wild animals if any.
- 2. The trap cameras will be supplied by user agency or amount for 25 nos as and when communicated by DCF alibag to MRVC will



be deposited of purchased by Oser agency and provided is 2.3.

Alibag in due course.

- The water tanks of 3 nos of size 10 x 5 m size will be constructed in deep area for the drinking water purposes to animals above tunnel ground surface in forest land as a mitigation measures.
 - 4. One small watch tower will be erected of 5 m (20 feet) m will be erected by user agency in top portion of affected forest and for security purpose.

These mitigations are sufficient for site specific as a 10 years management plan as jointly decided and the compliance for condition no. vi has been complied accordingly.

Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Wildlife) by letter with reference no 1 cited above directed Deputy Conservator of Forests (Wildlife) Thane to present at joint site inspection of Project area along with DCF (T) Alibag and Railway Officials and to guide for preparing Wildlife Conservation Plan. A joint site inspection was arranged on 8th March 2022 as per your letter with reference no 2 cited above.

The joint forest site inspection was done on 08.03.2022 in which you along with concerned RFO, field staff and Railway Officials were present. During the site inspection, Project Proponent showed Wild life Conservation Plan which was prepared by the proponent. Discussion was held with Forest and Railway officials present during site inspection on various aspects of the project and its impact on wildlife.

During the Site Inspection, Dy. It was avealed in Joint Site Inspection that mitigation measures are not feasible as 4.908 proposed evealed in John State of proposed areas for diversion is scattered and in many small patches and absence of wildlife therein

Considering the facts in the proposal, discussions held with Forest and Railway officials and based on Joint Site Inspection, it is recommended to erect chain-link fencing of 8m height and 100m length along both sides of the railway line at both the ends of the tunnels (i.e. before starting point and after the end point of the tunnels) with annual maintenance to avoid entry of any wild animal in the tunnel. It is also recommended to install necessary signage/direction boards depicting messages about wildlife conservation and helpline/contact of forest and railway officials to make people aware about wildlife conservation and to tackle situation of human wildlife conflict, if any in the future.

You are requested to make necessary corrections in the plan, by adding above recommendations in the Wildlife Conservation/mitigation Plan. Also, kindly take into consideration various provision of Wildlife corridor and Tiger Conservation Plan. if any regarding proposed forest area for diversion, before finalizing the Wildlife Conservation Plan submitted by the Project Proponent.
