

In this regard, it is requested to kindly grant working permission to diverted forest land at Morochi as 70% of Time period has been already expired, however we couldn't make land available to EPC Contractor as on date at these forest stretches, which may lead to additional cost burden to Public Exchequer due to anticipated EOT / claims from EPC Contractor apart from trouble to all stake holders for delayed construction activities on project stretch.





Sub: Regarding issuance of Naharkat Certificate Resolution under Forest Rights Act 2006.

Hon. Sub Divisional Officer and Land Acquisition Officer, Malshiras Sub Division, Akulj, issued Letter no. Work/Land acquisition/78/2021 dated 04/02/2021 stated that Sant Dnyaneshwar Maharaj Palkhi Highway 965 road is being quadrilateralized. For widening of this road, 0.78.93 sq.m. land from Morochi group no. 129 and 130 is being acquired. A meeting was held to discuss in detail whether the rights of any traditional Scheduled Tribes, Scheduled Castes and other traditional forest dwellers in the area are being violated under the Forest Rights Act and whose claims/objections have been received regarding the affected area.

Accordingly, in the acquired land of 0.78.93 sq.m. from Morochi group no. 129 and 130 found no cases of the rights infringement of traditional Scheduled Tribes, Scheduled Castes and other traditional forest dwellers under the Forest Rights Act of 2006. The Forest Rights Committee has no claims/objections of Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other traditional forest dwellers in this regard. Also, the old survey no. 81 and current group no. 140 has been **annihilated** on October 15, 1885, so this group does not come under a forest area.

In this regard, all the evidences were submitted in the hearing held before Hon. Sub-Divisional Officer, Akulj, on 01/03/2021 and a **diary** has been prepared in this regard. For the sake of information, it was unanimously decided to send a copy of the gazette and a copy of the **diary** to the Senior Office.


