Out of this 400.029 ha forest land, FC for 195.20 ha was obtained on 22.01.1999 including 12.708 ha of surface rights for infrastructure & approach road and FC for 3.75 ha was obtained vide 6-MPB-109/2006-BHO-3741 dt 16.8.2007. The remaining 201.079 ha is the present proposal.

It is our humble submission that WCL had complied stage-I condition in 195.20 Ha and issued stage-II by MOEF&CC no 8-97/97-FC dt 22.01.1999 so in present proposal NPV is applicable only for 201.079 ha.

The regional office, Bhopal shall visit the Tawa-II underground mining project and report the status of the forest clearance and the ongoing mining activities without valid forest clearance under section 2(ii) of the FC Act along with the Nodal officer, Forest Conservation, Madhya Pradesh Forest Department, WCL will provide the copy of FC granted in past along the with the details of the mining area of Tawa-II underground mining project over 520 ha which as per the EC report involves entire 520 ha of forest land.

Necessary action in this regard may please be taken by regional Office Bhopal and APCCF & Nodal Officer, Forest Conservation, Madhay Pradesh Forest Department

The Regional office Bhopal should investigate along with the concerned officers of the forest department and WCL the status of entire Pathakhera coal block in Madhya Pradesh, the extent of forest land and the status of forest clearance in all such cases and submit comprehensive report on Forest clearance.

Necessary action in this regard may please be taken by Regional Office Bhopal.

The details of Land Acquired and Forest Land involved therein are enclosed as Annexure-2 along with all the relevant approvals for the same.

WCL will deposit the NPV for the entire 520 ha immediately since the forest land has been used by the WCL in Tawa-II UG in contravention of the FC Act.

Land details of Tawa-II UG in point 2 is clearly showing that Tawa-II UG mine having 520 Ha total land which consists of forest land 396.279 ha. in which FC was already obtained for 195.20 Ha dated 22.01.1999 (FC details 8-97/97-FC dated 22.1.1999 - copy enclosed as Annexure-'3') and 201.079 is applied for FC.

Further, it is our humble submission that 201.079 ha is a virgin land which has not been broken till date. The proposal is, as such, for fresh diversion of the forest land rather for ex-facto regularization/ Post facto approval. The mining activity in the mine was started in 2006 with all necessary Statutory Clearances. As such, we request that approval may kindly be accorded on 201.079 ha without imposing any penalty as User Agency committed no violation of any Act.

As no work has been commenced under the 201.079 ha patch and hence WCL has completely complied and had submitted the proposal well in advance and now also no violation over the unapproved patch has been done.

Therefore, it is our humble submission that demand against NPV should be raised only for 201.079 Ha forest land for which present proposal was applied

Conservation Act, 1980 against the official who violated the provision of FC Act 1980. State Government may also initiate legal action under Indian Forest Act 1927 for violation of their relevant law.

upto 2029 and mining activity is going in this patch only. No mining activity was undertaken under 201.079 Ha forest land.

It is also prudent that WCL had applied for the diversion of 201.079 ha in the year 2008 vide proposal no. For approval for diversion under FC Act 1980.

As per the guidelines F.No .11-42/2007 FC dtd . 29.01.2018 issued by MoEF&CC regarding common guideline to be followed by FAC /REC for activities which constitutes violation of FCA 1980 and rules made thereof the action under Section 3A and 3B of FCA 1980 to be initiated for proposals in which proposal under FC has not been submitted and forest land is diverted without FC.

It is pertinent to mention here that, the application for diversion of 201.079 ha forest land was submitted by User Agency well in advance and **no** work has been commenced on the 201.079

ha patch and as such, this point i.e. action under Section 3A and 3B of FCA 1980 to be initiated for proposals in which proposal under FC has not been submitted may please not to be imposed on this case.

The state government will undertake study on impact of mining wildlife management plan for the entire reserve forest and the same will be implemented from the funds provided by the WCL. The clearance from NBWL may also be obtained because the area is populated by tigers in the surrounding tiger reserves

As it is an Underground Mine, there would be no impact on Wildlife due to Underground Mining.

However, necessary action in this regard may please be taken by State Govt. if deemed fit.

The proposal is for extension of the existing underground coalmine of a total ML area of 523.75 ha consisting of 400.029 ha of forestland and 123,721 ha of non-forestland. Mining would be restricted to 15 m from the eastern bank of Tawa River and during the extraction stage, a barrier of coal in the form of solid pillar of width based on angle of draw and depth of seam would be left in the area near Tawa River and HFL of Satpura reservoir. A meeting was held on 06.08.2019, in MoEF&CC, New Delhi with the officials of State Govt. and user agency regarding discussed the proposals about Shobapur, Tawa-II and Tawa-III of WCL UG mines at Pathakher, Betul, Madhya Pradesh, the minutes of the meeting as given under:

IGF (FC) welcomed the officials, representative from WCL presented an presentation explaining the total area of the underground mining. The Shobapur proposal was accorded Stage-I approval by the Ministry on 30m January, 2012 subject to certain conditions prescribed therein. WCL informed they have complied all the conditions prescribed and requested to provide Stage-II for this proposal.

Tawa II proposal was accorded in principle approval on 14.05.2018 with the ex-post-facto regularisation of the violation committed by the Western Coalfield Limited for diversion of the forest land over the forest land 201.079 ha of forest land already broken with penal NPV and penal CA, w.e.f. 25.10.1980. Further the in-principle approval will be effective after the payment of NPV and other outstanding dues with WCL in CAMPA account.

In which Condition No.(vi) Stated that NPV for entire 520 Ha has to submitted by WCL. With respect to this WCL officials explained they have submitted representation only for 396.279ha is forest land therefore NPV may be applicable for that. They also informed that the penalty amount imposed has been submitted in the CAMPA account and request to accord Stage-II approval for Tawa-II.

Further representative from WCL informed that a new proposal Tawa-III (101.600 hectares) have been submitted to this Ministry and a proposal for diversion of 25 ha area of the forest land area near Tawa-III (101.600 hectares) have also applied in RO, Bhopal. Accordingly the following decisions after hearing from all the officials present:

25 ha area project which was submitted for diversion in Regional Office, MoEF&CC, Bhopal will be transferred to MoEF&CC, New Delhi and 25 ha. area will be combined with the Tawa-III (101.6 ha) and will be considered as single

WCL has to clarify from Ministry of Coal whether MMDR act is applicable on the **/11.** land acquired by them and same may be conveyed to this Ministry. /iii. Details of the entire area of forest land and how much forest land is remaining with

Acquisition of forest land under Coal Bearing Areas (Acquisition & Development) Act, 1957 and applicability of provisions of MMDR Act, 1957 along with MC Rules, 1960 over the land/rights acquired under Coal Bearing Areas (Acquisition & Development) Act, 1957.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to WCL's letter No.WCL/MP(L/R)/MK/750 dated 9.10.2019 and WCL's letter No.WCL/GM/L&R)/AK/491 dated 16.05.2018 on the above mentioned subject. The requisite clarification of Ministry of Coal in the matter is as under:-

By virtue of the provisions of section 10 and 11 of the Coal Bearing Areas (Acquisition and Development) Act, 1957, the land or the rights in or over the land acquired under the Act vest absolutely with the Central Government or the naminee, that is, a Government Company. The land gets vested in the Central Government on the publication of notification under Section 9 and thereafter in the Govt. Company on the publication of declaration under Section 11(1) of the ibid Act. Accordingly, since the land acquired under the Act vests absolutely in the Government Company, there is no necessity for execution of Mining Lease with the State Government. The issue of requirement of Mining Lease in case of lands acquired under CBA Act has been settled by Hon'ble Supreme Court in Bharet Coking Coal Ltd Vs. State of Bihar [1987 (Suppl) SCC 394], wherein the Court observed that "once the acquisition is made under the Coal Bearing Areas (Acquisition and Development) Act, 1957, requisite declaration was issued by the Central Government, it was not open to the State Government to grant Lease as the land vests in the Central Government". The said findings of the Hon ble Supreme Court has also been followed by the Division bench of High Court of MP in Western Coalfields Limited and Ors vs State of MP and Am (AIR 2007 MP 75).

2. Since the subject land was acquired under the CBA(A&D) Act, 1957 and vests absolutely in the Government Company, neither the execution of mining lease with the State Government is required as per statute nor there is any necessity as it was not open to State Government to grant lease and therefore provisions of MMDR Act, 1957

along with the Mineral Concessions Rules, 1960 does not apply over the land/rights acquired under CBA(A&D) Act, 1957. Therefore the land in respect of Tawa-II UG, Satpura-II UG, Shobhapur UG mine of Pathakhera area and similar acquisition of WCL acquired under Section 9(1) of CBA (A&D) Act, 1957, the provisions of MMDR Act, 1957 and MC Rules, 1960 does not apply.
