Please refer to above mentioned letter vide which DPR Consultant M/s LEA Associate South Asia Pvt. Ltd. has submitted of Stage-1 compliance report for 2.33 Ha of Forest land required for the road Vidisha-Mehlua-Talbehat for Forest Clearance to this office & request to write a letter to Forest department for issuing the necessary permission for commence the subject work including tree cutting etc.in forest land.
