





The new rates will also be applicable on all the cases that were granted Stage-I / in-principle approval prior to 06.01.2022 and where even after lapse of 5 years, the Stage-II/Final approval is not granted due to non-submission of complete compliance of the conditions stipulated in Stage-I / in-principle approval.

This clarification is issued in suppression of earlier order no. 5-3/2011-FC (Vol-I) dated 19.01.2022.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to State Govt. letter No10F(Cons)276/2016-726WF&E dated 06.04.2018 on the above mentioned subject seeking prior approval of the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change under section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.

2. After due consideration of the proposal of the State Government and on the basis of decision of Regional Empowered Committee meeting held on 23.04.2018, the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change hereby conveys 'in-principle' approval for diversion of 9.441 ha of forest land in Lamdunguri RF for construction of additional Spillway of Hirakud Dam Project, Burla in Sambalpur district in the State of Odisha, subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions.

- i) Legal status of forest land proposed for diversion shall remain unchanged.
- ii) The State Govt. shall charge the Net Present Value (NPV) of forest area proposed to be diverted under this proposal from the user agency as per the Orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 28.03.2008, 24.04.2008 and 09.05.2008 in Writ Petition (Civil) No.202/1995 and the guidelines issued by this Ministry vide its letter No. 5-3/2007-FC dated 05.02.2009 in this regard. While conveying the compliance of this condition, mention be made of the Eco-class and density of forest for which NPV has been charged.
- iii) At the time of payment of the Net Present Value (NPV) at the present rate, the user agency shall furnish an undertaking to pay the additional amount of NPV, if so determined, as per the final decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.
- iv) Compensatory afforestation shall be raised over 9.441 ha of non-forest land identified in Plot No.1292, Khata No.1/1, Kisan Ghasapadia of village Kello under Bonai Tahasil of Sundargarh district against the area of forest land proposed to be diverted at the cost of the user agency.
- v) The non-forest land identified for raising compensatory afforestation shall be transferred and mutated in favour of the State Forest Department before issue of Stage-II approval.

- vi) State Govt. will formulate the compensatory afforestation scheme with focused soil & moisture conservation, along with regeneration cleaning, silvicultural activities and shall ensure maintenance of these plantations for a period of seven to ten years as per requirement.
- vii) The non-forest land over which compensatory afforestation will be taken up shall be notified as PF/RF and shall remain under the administrative control of the State Forest Department.
- viii) The user agency shall comply with the conditions stipulated by State Govt. vide letter No.1(X/Cons)276/2016-7866F&E dated 06.04.2018.
- ix) All the funds received from the user agency under the project shall be transferred through e-portal to the Ad-hoc CAMPA in the Saving Bank Account pertaining to the State concerned. The user agency should ensure that the compensatory levies (C.A. cost, NPV etc.) are deposited through challan generated online on web portal and deposited in appropriate bank online only. Amount deposited through other mode will not be accepted as compliance of the Stage-I clearance.
- x) The boundary of the forest land proposed to be diverted shall be demarcated on the ground at the project cost, by erecting four feet high reinforced cement concrete pillars, each inscribed with its serial number, DGPS coordinates, distance from adjoining pillars etc. As per Ministry's letter No.13-20/2015-CAMPA dated 09.06.2016, the cost of expenditure like boundary walls, stone pillars, demarcation charges, charges for felling of trees and their transportation to depots shall be deposited with DFOs concerned and the work should be undertaken departmentally in order to ensure that the task of erection of boundary walls, stone pillars, demarcation charges etc. are undertaken faithfully and in the best interests of the forests before the diversion and handing over of the forest land takes place. The work on these items should be completed within 6 months from the grant of final approval to diversion of forest land.
- xi) The State Forest Department/UA shall submit the surveyed sketch of non-forest land identified for CA, giving the forward and backward bearing of each demarcation pillar and distance between them. The State Forest Department/User Agency shall submit the DGPS reading of each demarcated pillar giving the latitude and the longitude.
- xii) The user agency shall plant trees in available vacant spaces, as per feasibility, around the project site at their own cost, maintaining a record and for annual report, self compliance submission.
- xiii) No labour camp shall be established on the forest land.
- xiv) The user agency shall provide alternate fuel preferably LPG to the labourers and the staff working at the site so as to avoid any damage and pressure on the adjacent forest areas.
- xv) No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for any activity related to the project work.
- xvi) Earth or any material shall neither be brought from nor the debris resulting during construction be disposed of in the adjoining forest area by the user agency.

- xvii) The user agency while executing works, shall not fell any tree or damage forest growth in the surrounding forest area in any manner.
- xviii) The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the proposal and under no circumstances be transferred to any other user agency, department or person without prior approval of the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change.
- xix) The State Government shall complete settlement of rights, in term of the Scheduled Tribes and Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006, if any, on the forest land to be diverted and submit the documentary evidence as prescribed by this Ministry in its letter No.11-9/1998-FC (pt.) dated 03.08.2009 read with letter No.11-9/1998-FC (pt.) dated 05.02.2013 and 05.07.2013, in support thereof. The user agency shall submit original FRA certificate before issue of Stage-II approval.
- xx) Any other conditions that Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change may stipulate, from time to time, in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests and wildlife shall be complied by the user agency.
- xxi) The State Govt. and user agency shall ensure compliance to provisions of the all Acts, Rules, Regulations, Guidelines, NGT Order (s) & Hon'ble Court Order (s) pertaining to this project, if any, for the time being in force, as applicable to the project.

After receipt of the report on compliance to the conditions stipulated above, from the State Government of Odisha, final/Stage-II approval for diversion of the said forest land under Section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 will be issued by this Ministry. Transfer of forest land to user agency shall not be effected by the State Government of Odisha till final/Stage-II approval for its diversion is issued by the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change. However, the State Govt., if it so desires, may allow the user agency for commencement of work as per Ministry guideline issued vide letter No.11-306/2014-FC dated 28.08.2015.

a) INTRODUCTION:

Stage -I forest clearance was given for the construction of an additional spillway on the left dyke of the Hirakud dam project from MoEF &CC. As per the conditions in Sl. No. 14C stipulated by state government vide letter no. 10(Cons)276/2016-7866/F&E, Dt.06.04.2018, the user agency shall bear the cost of plantation of 10 times the trees felled from non-forest area with 10 years of maintenance. In this regard a land of 30 Ha. has been earmarked at village Jamadarpali, in Sambalpur tehsil under Sadar range of Sambalpur forest division.

b) IDENTIFICATION OF THE DEGRADED FOREST AREA:

The land for this purpose has been identified in Jamadarpali village in Sadar Range of Sambalpur Forest Division under Sambalpur Tehsil in Sambalpur District. The identified area is in one patch of 30Ha. of degraded village forest land. The area has been inspected by the Range Officer, Sadar Range and found suitable for taking up Compensatory Afforestation. The map showing the proposed Compensatory Afforestation is shown in *Annexure-1*.

(a) Existing Vegetation:

The Jamadarpali village Forest under Sadar Range, Sambalpur Tehsil of Sambalpur District is situated approx. 10 Km away from Sadar Range office. The land vegetation is scrub with very few number of trees are present.

(b) Soil and topography:

The topography of the area is moderately undulated terrain and having approx. 15% slope. The soil is sandy loam and gritty, hard compact and with some moorumpatches on the slope. Depth of the soil is fairly good. The soil is mainly devoid of humus and shallow in depth.

(c) Temperature:

The area experiences sub-tropical climate. It is characterized by very hot summer and cool winter. Maximum temperature during summer rises up to 35-48 degree Celsius and in winter it goes down to 5-10 degree Celsius.

(d) Rain fall:

The area gets rain from South-West monsoon, which breaks during second fortnight of June and continues until last week of September. The annual rainfall varies from 1259.0 mm to 1441.0 mm. The annual rainfall average is 1350 mm. The bulk of precipitation occurs during July-August. During April-May, occasional rainfall occurs along with thunder storm. The annual rain fall varies from 1200 mm to 1500 mm mostly received during rainy season from July to September.

3. OBJECTIVE OF THE SCHEME:

The main objective of the scheme is to restore the forest vegetation in Jamadarpali village Forest in lieu of the diverted forest land. This will help in socio-economic and environmental wellbeing of the fringe villagers also help in restore the biodiversity of the area. The scheme also envisages carrying out adequate and appropriate soil conservation measures along with the afforestation work so as to conserve soil and water for recharging the ground water table and to check erosion of the fertile top soil.

Principal Aims of the proposed scheme: -

- (i) Compensatory afforestation of trees felled (10times) from non-forest area.
- (ii) To rehabilitate the degraded forest land through plantation with suitable indigenous species.
- (iii) To arrest soil erosion and to improve the soil-moisture regime of the area which will ultimately recharge the ground water.
- (iv) To create a compact forest, which will be an asset for the local people from environmental, economic and aesthetic points of view.
- (v) To help reduce environmental pollution.

ITEMS OF WORK TO BE TAKEN UP:

To achieve the objective narrated in the foregoing para, the following items of work are mainly prescribed to be taken up:

1. SURVEY AND DEMARCATION:

The proposed Compensatory Plantation Area will survey and demarcated. The entire area will be fenced with barbed wire fencing for protection.

2. PLANTATION:

In the proposed compensatory afforestation total 45,460 seedlings will be planted as per forest department norms in approx. 30 Ha area. The scheme details of plantation and maintenance for 10 years is attached in the report. For the restoration of the lost biodiversity, suitable indigenous species will be planted with keeping eye on local people's livelihood opportunity in long term. The proposed seedling species are following:

1. Neem (*Azadirachta indica*)
2. Bahada (*Terminalia belerica*)
3. Jamun (*Syzygium cumini*)
4. Neem (*Azadirachta indica*)
5. Gambhar (*Gmelina arborea*)
6. Amala (*Emblica officinalis*)
7. Bel (*Aegle marmelos*)
8. Karanja (*Pongamia pinnata*)
9. Bamboo (*Dendrocalamus strictus*)
10. Asan (*Terminalia tomentosa*)
11. Jackfruit (*Artocarpus Heterophyllus*)
12. Siris (*Albizzia Lebbeck*)
13. Tamarind (*Tamarindus Indica*)
14. Aata (*Annona squamosa*)
15. Ficus species (5%)

3. ENTRY POINT ACTIVITY (EPA) AND CAPACITY BUILDING OF FRINGE VILLAGE/VSS (VANA SHURAKSHYA SAMITI):

An EPA refers to small-scale assistance for the creation of community assets and should address the common urgent needs of the entire community. The aim of providing EPAs is to gain the trust of the village residents towards the protection of plantation sites by satisfying their immediate demands. EPAs generally implemented in coordination with the local government and other departments of Odisha to avoid duplication and enhance efficiency of public service delivery. There are 4 villages near to the site i.e. Jamadarpali, Jogipali, Ranibandh and Sonu-Tikra. So there will be efforts towards capacity building and awareness on regards of protection of plantation from grazing, fire etc. with local villagers' cooperation.

4. FENCING:

As this area is within the village forest area, there is every possibility of grazing by stray animal. It is therefore proposed for Barbed wire fencing along the surveyed boundaries to prevent grazing.

I am directed to State Govt. letter No 10F(Cons)/276/2016-7866/F&E dated 06.04.2018 on the above mentioned subject seeking prior approval of the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change under section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.
2 After due consideration of the State Government and on the basis of decision of Regional Empowered committee meeting held on 23.04.2018, the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change hereby conveys 'in-principle' approval for diversion of 9.441 ha of Forest land in Landunguri RF for construction of additional Spillway of Hirakud Dam Project, Burla in Sambalpur district in the State of Odisha, subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:
i) Legal status of the land proposed for diversion shall remain unchanged.
ii) The State Govt. shall charge Net Present Value (NPV) of forest area proposed to be diverted under this proposal from the user agency as per the Order of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 28.03.2008 and 09.05.2008 in Writ Petition (Civil) No. 202/1995 and the guidelines issued by this Ministry vide its letter no. 5-3/2007-FC dated 05.02.2009 in this regard. While conveying the compliance of this condition, mention be made of the Eco-class and density of forest for which NPV has been charged.
iii) At the time of payment of the Net Present Value (NPV) at the present rate, the user agency shall furnish an undertaking to pay the additional amount of NPV, if so determined, as per the final decision of the Hon'ble Supreme court of India.
iv) Compensatory afforestation shall be raised over 9.441 Ha of nonforest land identified in plot no. 1292, Khata no. 1/1, Ksiam-Ghasapadia of village Kello under Bonai Tahasil of Sundergarh district against the area of forest land proposed to be diverted at the cost of the user agency.
v) The non-forest land identified for raising compensatory afforestation shall be transferred and mutated in favour of the State Forest Department before issue of stage-II approval.
vi) State Govt. will formulate compensatory afforestation scheme with focused soil & moisture conservation along with regeneration, cleaning, silvicultural activities and shall ensure maintenance of these plantations for the period of seven years to ten years as per requirement.
vii) The non-forest land over which compensatory afforestation will be taken up shall be notified as PFRF and shall remain under the administrative control of the State Forest Department.
viii) The user agency shall comply with the conditions stipulated by state Govt. vide letter No 10(Cons)/276/2016-7866/F&E dated 06.04.2018.
ix) All the funds received from the user agency under the project shall be transferred through e-portal to the Ad-hoc CAMPA in the Saving Bank Account pertaining to the State concerned. The user agency should ensure that the compensatory levies (CA cost, NPV etc) are deposited through compliance of the Stage-I clearance.
x) The boundary of the forest land proposed to be diverted shall be demarcated on the ground at the project cost, by erecting four feet reinforced cement concrete pillars, each inscribed with its serial number, DGPS coordinates, distance from adjoining pillars etc. As per Ministry letter no. 13-20/2015-CAMPA dated 09.06.2016, the cost of expenditure like boundary walls, stone pillars, demarcation charges, charges for feeling of trees and their transportation to depots shall be deposited with DFOs concerned and the work should be undertaken departmentally in order to ensure that the task of erection of boundary walls, stone pillars, demarcation charges etc. are undertaken faithfully and in the best interest of the forests before the diversion and handing over of the forest land takes place. The work on these items should be completed within 6 months from the grant of final approval to diversion of forest land.
xi) The state forest department/JA shall submit the surveyed sketch of non-forest land identified for CA, giving the forward bearing and backward demarcated pillar giving latitude and the longitude.
xii) The user agency shall plant trees in available vacant spaces as per feasibility around the project site at their own cost, maintaining a record and for annual report call from the concerned authority.

xiii) No labour camp shall be established on the forest land.
xiv) The user agency shall provide alternate fuel preferably LPG to the labourers and the staff working at the site so as to avoid any damage and pressure on the adjacent forest areas.
xv) No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for any activity related to the project work.
xvi) Earth or any material shall neither be brought from nor the debris resulting during construction be deposited in the adjoining forest area by user agency.
xvii) The user agency while executing works, shall not fell any tree of damage forest growth in the surrounding forest area in any manner.
xviii) The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than specific in the proposal and under no circumstances be transferred to any of the user agency, department or person without prior approval of the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change.
xix) The State Government shall complete settlement of rights, in term of the Scheduled Tribe and Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Acts 2006, if any, on the forest land to be diverted and submit the documentary evidence as prescribed by this Ministry in its letter no. 11-9/1998-FC (pt.) dated 03.08.2009 read with letter no 11-9/1998-FC (pt.) dated 05.02.2013 and 05.07.2013, in support thereof. The user agency shall submit original FRA certificate before issue of stage-II approval.
xx) Any other conditions that Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change may stipulate, from time to time, the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests and wildlife shall be complied by the user agency.
xxi) The State Govt. and the user agency shall ensure compliance to provisions of the all Acts, Rules, Regulations, Guidelines, NGT order(s) & Hon'ble Court order(s) pertaining to the project, if any, for the time being in force, as applicable to the project.
After receipt of the report on compliance to the conditions stipulated above, from the State Government of Odisha, final/Stage-II approval for diversion of the said forest land under Section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 will be issued by this Ministry. Transfer of forest land to user agency shall not be effected by the State Government of Odisha till final/Stage-II approval for its diversion is issued by the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change. However, the State Govt., if it so desires, may allow the user agency for commencement of work as per Ministry guideline issued vide letter No. 11-306/2014-FC dated 28.08.2015.

In the above said Stage-I approval order, there is no order for transferring the forest land in favour of the user agency for which proposal was earlier forwarded by the State Government to Government of India, MoEF & CC, Eastern Regional Office vide letter No- 7866/F & E dt. 06.04.2018. The Stage-I approval order referred to above indicates that Government of India MoEF&CC, Eastern Regional Office agrees for diversion of above extend of forest land subject to compliance of 21 (twenty one) no. of conditions by the user agency so as to consider the case for Stage-II (final) forest clearance.
