Annexure - I**UNDERTAKING**

We do hereby undertake to bear the following cost if any on demand and also do hereby undertake to do the following works as per conditions stipulated in Stage I order by MoEF, Govt. of India vide order dated 04.03.2020 and vide letter dated 21.03.2020 of Govt. of Odisha, F&E Department.

- i) The legal status of the forest land will remain unchanged as per the stipulated **condition No. 2(i) of MoEF&CC letter dtd. 04.03.2020.**
- ii) We will pay any Additional amount of the NPV of the diverted forest land, if any, as per demand of forest department as per stipulated **condition No. 2(vi) of MoEF&CC letter dtd. 04.03.2020.**
- iii) We will take prior approval of the Central Government under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 in respect of any non-forestry work required over 1.695 ha of forest land involved in the safety zone as per the stipulated **condition No. 2(viii) of MoEF&CC letter dtd. 04.03.2020.**
- iv) We will pay the cost of felling of trees as and when demand by the State Forest Department as per the stipulated **condition No. 2(xi) of MoEF&CC letter dtd. 04.03.2020.**
- v) The period of diversion of the forest land under this approval shall be for a period co-terminus with the period of the mining lease to be granted under Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957, or Rules framed thereunder as per the stipulated **condition No. 2(xv) of MoEF&CC letter dtd. 04.03.2020.**
- vi) There will be no labour camp established inside the forest land as per the stipulated **condition No. 2(xvi) of MoEF&CC letter dtd. 04.03.2020.**

- vii) We will provide LPG to the labourers and the staff working at the site as per the stipulated **condition No. 2(xvii) of MoEF&CC letter dtd. 04.03.2020.**
- viii) We will fell any trees or damage forest growth in the surrounding forest areas as per the stipulated **condition No. 2(xviii) of MoEF&CC letter dtd. 04.03.2020.**
- ix) The layout plan of the proposed forest land will not change without prior approval of MoEF&CC as per the stipulated **condition No. 2(xix) of MoEF&CC letter dtd. 04.03.2020.**
- x) The forest land will not use any other purpose specified in the proposal as per the stipulated **condition No. 2(xx) of MoEF&CC letter dtd. 04.03.2020.**
- xi) We will abide any additional conditions imposed by Regional Office (Eastern Zone), Bhubaneswar, MoEF&CC and the Govt. of Odisha from time to time, in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forest & wildlife as per the stipulated **condition No. 2(xxi) of MoEF&CC letter dtd. 04.03.2020.**
- xii) We will abide any the Act, Rules, Regulations and Guidelines for the time being in force as applicable to the project as per the stipulated **condition No. 2(xxii) of MoEF&CC letter dtd. 04.03.2020.**

Appendix – I

Compliance to conditions stipulated by MoEF&CC in stage –I approval order Dated 04.03.2020 for diversion of 1.81 ha of forest land in addition to the earlier diversion over 23.581 ha for mining and allied activities in respect of Patabeda Iron Mines of M/s MGM Minerals Ltd. in village Patabeda under Koira Tahasil of Sundergarh District, Odisha.

- i) ***Legal status of the diverted forest land shall remain unchanged;***

Legal status of the diverted forest land shall remain unchanged. An undertaking to this effect is enclosed vide **Annexure- 1.**

- ii) ***Compensatory afforestation shall be raised over 1.81 ha of non-forest land identified in Khata No. 132, Plot No. 1155, Kissam Patharabani o village Phuljhar under Lahunipara Tahasil of Sundargarh district by the State Govt. at the cost of user agency. As far as practicable a mixure of local indigenous species will be planted and monoculture of a species has to be avoided ;***

Non – forest land over 1.81 ha has been identified and allotted by the Collector, Sundargarh in village Phuljhar under Lahunipara Tahasil of Bonai forest Division. A sum of Rs. 13,10,100/- towards the cost of Compensatory afforestation as per the scheme approved at the current wage rate of Rs. 308/- per MD with a maintenance for 10 years has been deposited through RTGS vide Ref. No. SBINR52021020609959118, dt. 06.02.2021. The copy of the remittance receipt is enclosed vide **Annexure-II.**

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- iii) The non-forest land identified for raising compensatory afforestation shall be transferred and mutated in favour of the State Forest Department before issue of the Stage II approval;**

Non – forest land over 1.81 ha has been identified and allotted in village Phuljhar under Lahunipara Tahasil has been mutated and transferred in favour of State Forest Department vide order No 1275, dt. 22.06.2021 of Tahasildar, Lahunipada.

- iv) The cost of Compensatory Afforestation at the prevailing wage rates as per Compensatory Afforestation Scheme and at the cost of survey, demarcation and erection of permanent pillars if required on the CA land shall be deposited in advance with Forest Department by the project authority. The CA will be maintained for 10 years. The scheme may include appropriate provision for anticipated cost increase for work schedule for subsequent year ;**

The approved cost of Compensatory Afforestation at the current wage rate of Rs. 308/- per MD with a maintenance for 10 years and includes appropriate provision for anticipated cost increase for works scheduled for subsequent years amounting to Rs. 13,10,100/- only has been deposited in the CAMPA Fund through RTGS mode vide Ref. No. SBINR52021020609959118, dt. 06.02.2021. The copy of the remittance receipt is enclosed vide **Annexure- II.**

- v) State Government shall charge the Net Present Value (NPV) for 1.81 ha forest area to be diverted under this proposal, if not paid, from the User Agency as per the Orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 30.10.2002, 0108.2003, 28-03-2008, 24-04-2008 and 09-05-2008 in IA No. 566 in Writ Petition (Civil) No.202/1995 and as per the guidelines issued by this Ministry vide letter No.5-1/1998-FC (Pt.II) dated 18.09.2003 as**

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well as letter No.5-2/2006-FC dated 03.10.2006 and 5-3/2007-FC05-02-2009 in this regard;

As per the earlier demand we have paid Rs. 1,62,35,630/- over entire forest land (over 27.086 ha) involved within the lease area as per the Orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 30.10.2002, 0108.2003, 28-03-2008, 24-04-2008 and 09-05-2008 in IA No. 566 in Writ Petition (Civil) No.202/1995 and as per the guidelines issued by this Ministry vide letter No.5-1/1998-FC (Pt.II) dated 18.09.2003 as well as letter No.5-2/2006-FC dated 03.10.2006 and 5-3/2007-FC05-02-2009 in this regard. Further, the differential amount of Rs. 3,78,290/- towards Net Present Value (NPV) over 1.81 ha of forest land has been deposited in the CAMPA Fund through RTGS mode vide Ref. No. SBINR52020070100111554, dt. 01.07.2020. The copy of the remittance receipt is enclosed vide **Annexure-III.**

- vi) Additional amount of the NPV of the diverted forest land, if any, becoming due after finalization of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on receipt of the report from the Expert Committee, shall be charged by the State Govt. from the User Agency. The user agency shall furnish an undertaking to this effect.**

An Undertaking to this effect is enclosed vide **Annexure - I.**

- vii) All the funds received from the User Agency under the project shall be transferred/deposited to State CAMPA fund only through (<https://parivesh.nic.in/>).**

- viii) *The user agency shall obtained prior approval of the Central Government under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 in respect of 1.695 ha of forest land, earmarked as a safety zone area of 1.886 ha, involved in the mining lease in accordance with the provisions of guidelines, as provided under para 7.9 of the Handbook of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.*

An Undertaking to this effect is enclosed vide **Annexure - I.**

- ix) *In accordance with the provisions given under Para 1.21 of the Handbook of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 , State Govt. shall realize NPV equal to twice the normal NPV, for violation of the conditions stipulated in the approval dated 30.12.2005, committed by using the forest area amounting to 0.50 ha for the purpose other than what was approved by the Central Govt.*

The amount of Rs. 9,39,000/- towards the violation of the conditions stipulated in the approval dated 30.12.2005, committed by using the forest area amounting to 0.50 ha has been deposited in the CAMPA Fund through RTGS mode vide Ref. No. SBINR52020070100111554, dt. 01.07.2020. The copy of the remittance receipt is enclosed vide **Annexure- III.**

- x) *Compliance of the condition stipulated in the Stage - II approval dated 30.12.2005 shall be examined and violation of conditions, if any, shall be dealt with as per provisions provided in Para 1.21 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 before considering the proposal for grant of Stage - II approval.*



The self-assessment report of the condition stipulated in the Stage II approval dt. 30.12.2005 for the year 2020 is enclosed as **Annexure - V**.

- xi) The cost of felling of trees shall be deposited by the user agency with the State Forest Department.***

The cost of feeling of trees will be deposited to the State Forest Department as and when demand by the State Forest Department. An Undertaking to this effect is enclosed vide **Annexure - I**.

- xii) The user agency shall ensure demarcation of boundary of safety zone (7.5 meter strip all along the inner boundary of the mining lease area), and its protection by erecting adequate number of 6 feet RCC boundary pillars inscribed with DGPS coordinates with barbed wire fencing and deploying adequate number of watchers under the Supervision of the State Forest Department. Safety Zone shall be raised and maintained by the user agency/State Govt. in accordance with the relevant guidelines issued by the Ministry.***

Demarcation of boundary of 7.5 mtrs of safety zone all along the mine boundary erecting 6 feet of RCC pillars inscribed DGPS coordinates with barbed wire fencing and provided adequate number of watch and word for protecting the plantation.

- xiii) User agency shall obtain the Environment Clearance as per the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, if required,***

State Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA), Odisha has accorded Environmental clearance for 1.5 MTPA Iron ore vide letter No.SEIAA/42402/07-MINB1/09-2019_7702/SEIAA dated 03.01.2020



(copy of the same is enclosed as **Annexure -VI**. Further State Pollution Control Board, Odisha has accorded Consent to Operate for 1.5 MTPA Iron ore vide letter No. 2726/IND-I-CON-5427, dated 07.03.2020, copy of the same is enclosed as **Annexure -VII**.

- xiv) The complete compliance of the FRA, 2006 shall be ensured by way of prescribed certificate from the concerned District Collector.*

The Collector, Sundargarh has issued Certificate under the Forest Rights Act'2006 over entire forest area involved within the mining lease area. Copy of the same is enclosed as **Annexure - VIII**.

- xv) The Period of diversion of the said forest land under this approval shall be for a period co-terminus with the period of the mining lease to be granted under Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act,1957,or Rules framed there under.*

The period of diversion of the said forest land under this approval shall be co-terminus with the period of the mining lease granted under the Mines and Minerals (Development & Regulation) Act, 1957, or Rules framed there under. An Undertaking to this effect is enclosed as **Annexure - I**.

- xvi) No labour camp shall be established on the forest land.*

No labour camp will be established inside the forest area. An Undertaking to this effect is enclosed vide **Annexure - I**.

- xvii) The user agency shall provide LPG to the labourers and the staff working at the site so as to avoid any damage and pressure on the adjacent forest land.*



The User Agency has arranged accommodation of all the workers working at the site. The food arrangement has prepared at its own camp and the food is prepared in LPG.

xviii) The user agency while executing works, shall not fell any tree or damage forest growth in the surrounding forest area in any manner.

An Undertaking to this effect is enclosed vide **Annexure – I.**

xix) The layout plan of the proposed forest land shall not be changed without prior approval of Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change.

The layout plan of the proposed forest land will not change without prior approval of MoEF&CC. An Undertaking to this effect is enclosed vide **Annexure – I.**

xx) The Forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the proposal and under no circumstances be transferred to any other user agency, department or person without the prior approval of Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change;

The Forest Land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the proposal. An Undertaking to this effect is enclosed vide **Annexure – I.**

xxi) Any other condition that the Regional Office (Eastern Zone), Bhubaneswar of this Ministry and the Government of Odisha may stipulate, from time to time, in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forest & wildlife, which shall be complied by the user agency;

An Undertaking to this effect is enclosed as **Annexure - I.**



xxii) The State Govt. and user agency shall ensure compliance to provisions of the Acts, Rules, Regulations, Guidelines NGT Order (s) & Hon'ble Court Order (s) pertaining to this project, if any, for the time being in force, as applicable to the project;

With reference to above, this is to inform you that the Scheme for Compensatory Afforestation over **1.81 ha.** of non-forest Govt. land identified in village **Fuljhar** under Lahunipara Tahasil of this Division in lieu of above said diversion proposal has revised and approved by the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Forest Diversion & Nodal Officer, F.C. Act' O/O the P.C.C.F., Odisha, Bhubaneswar for **₹13,10,100/-** at the wage rate of ₹308/- per MD vide his Memo No. under reference (2).

Earlier, you have been demanded vide this office Letter No. under reference (3) to deposit ₹13,01,700/- towards cost Compensatory Afforestation @ ₹303.40 per MD. But, you have not yet deposited the same.






