Sub: Upgradation to 2 lane with paved shoulder/ 4 lane of Khajuwala - Poogal Section (Design chainage 0+000 to 30+812) and Poogal - Dantour - Jaggsar - Gokul - Goddu- Ranjitpura - Charanwala - Naukh - Bap section of NH-911 under Bharatmala Pariyojana in the State of Rajasthan on Hybrid Annuity Model.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the above cited subject matter it is submitted that FCA Stage-I approval was accorded by MoEFCC, Gol on 16.10.2020. The compliance report of Stage-I approval was submitted by this office to concern DCF-IGNP, Bikaner & Chattargarh on 17.12.2021.

IRO, MoEFCC, Jaipur raised the EDS on 31.08.2022 which was forwarded by you to this office on 07.09.2022. Reply of the same was uploaded by this office on 26.01.2023 and 07.08.2023. Your office again uploaded the EDS on 21.10.2023 stating that “FRA certificate is incomplete, kindly provide proper FRA certificate”.

It is brought to your kind notice that the forest land involved in the proposal was 11.8259 Ha, for which stage-I approval was accorded and accordingly compliances regarding fund for NPV, CA etc were also deposited for 11.8259 Ha. Collector, Bikaner issued the FRA certificate for 8.0285 Ha only, stating that out of the land involved in the proposal, forest land is 8.0285 Ha only remaining land is revenue land, not forest land. The Final compliance report submitted in the matter had the FRA certificate for 8.0285 Ha only and that is the main reason for raising the EDS.


We had requested concern DCF and CCF, Bikaner time and again to resolve the issue regarding area of Forest Land in the matter with concern Revenue Authorities and resolve the issue.

This proposal comes under Bharatmala Pariyojna and has strategic importance of Border Roads. Chairman, NHAI, New Delhi vide DO letter dated 14.11.23 has also requested Chief Secretary, GoR to intervene in the matter and expediting approval of FCA Stage-II permission.

In this regard, it requested that no any action is required to be taken by NHAI for issuance of proper FRA certificate, as desired by you. Hence you are requested to kindly get the issue resolved and expedite Stage-II approval in the matter.

Respected Man,

As you are aware, NHAI is executing various projects in Rajasthan including highways of strategic importance near the border areas in western Rajasthan. In this connection, NHAI has constructed upgradation of 2-lane with paved shoulder/ 4-lane of Khajuwal-Poogal-Bap section under Bharatmala Pariyojana.

2. During execution, a land comprising 11.852 Ha. was identified by Forest Dept. as forest land, accordingly NHAI submitted the proposal for diversion of forest land in the year 2020 and thereafter 1st stage clearance was issued and working permission granted by Forest Dept., Govt. of Rajasthan on 03.03.2021.

3. Subsequently, in compliance of the conditions of Stage-1 approval, Collector, Bikaner issued FRA Certificate of 8.0285 Ha land only, as the remaining 3.7974 Ha land belongs to Revenue Dept. as per their records. NHAI has already submitted all the compliances of Stage-II to the Forest Dept on 17.12.2021, however, Stage-II clearance is pending due to the FRA Certificate of remaining 3.7974 Ha. Land which is not forest land as per revenue record.

4. I request your kind intervention in this matter and issue necessary directions to concerned officials for expediting approval of FCA Stage-II permission.
