It is to inform that the Government of Telangana vide reference 5th cited has issued In Principle (Stage-I) approval and the same is communicated by the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF) Telangana, Hyderabad vide reference 6th cited above. Further the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF) Telangana, Hyderabad has also issued instructions to raise the demand notice to the M/s Telangana Fiber Grid Corporation Limited, Hyderabad (User Agency) in consultation with the Chief Conservator of Forests, Warangal and the Nodal Officer (FCA) as per the conditions issued vide reference 4th cited-above, and to obtain the compliance report from the User Agency and furnish through Chief Conservator of Forests, Warangal for obtaining Stage-II (final) approval.

Accordingly, the demand notice to be raised over the User Agency is prepared and the details are as follows:

The user agency needs to upload the practice of notice against the project for approval by Nodal Officer (FCA), Telanguna and gener



Attention of the officers noted in the address entry is invited to the references cited and they are informed that in exercise of the powers delegated to the State Government by the Government of India, Ministry of Environment & Forests, New Delhi in the reference 1st cited, the State Government vide G.O.8th cited(copy enclosed) have accorded in-principle (Stage-I) approval- for "diversion of forest land to an extent of 0.5873 ha in WLM Eturunagaram forest division of Mulugu District for laying of Optical Fiber Cable along the road within the existing Right of Way for execution of T-Fiber Project in favour of M/s. Telangana Fiber Grid Corporation Limited, Hyderabad," subject to compliance of conditions stipulated therein; and requested the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Head of Forest Force) to take further necessary action in the matter accordingly.

A. Action to be taken by the Forest Department:

The District Forest Officer, Mulugu district is therefore requested to prepare demand note for payment of compensatory levies by the M/s.Telangana Fiber Grid Corporation Limited,

Hyderabad (User Agency) [for C.No. 3(ii) - Demarcation of forest land, C.No.3(iii) - Net Present Value, C.No. 3(v) - Wildlife Mitigation measures, C.No. 3(vi) - Part II, III, IV conditions] as per the actual rates and submit the demand note through email for vetting and raise the demand with the User Agency after approval, duly indicating the account into which the amounts to be deposited by the User Agency.

As per the guidelines issued by the Ministry for depositing the funds into Adhoc CAMPA account of Telangana State, the User Agency needs to upload the demand notice online at Ministry's portal i.e., https://parivesh.nic.in.// against the project for approval by the Nodal Officer, FCA and upon approval, the User Agency shall generate challan and transfer funds into the account number mentioned in the challan.

Note: As per the clarification issued by the Ad-hoc CAMPA Wing vide F.No.13-20/2015-CAMPA, Dt.09.06.2016, the charges for felling, logging, transportation of project affected trees & the funds towards expenditure like boundary walls, stone pillars, demarcation charges etc., if any, should be deposited with the Divisional Forest Officers (now FDOs/DFOs) concerned and the work should be undertaken departmentally in-order to ensure that the task of felling / transportation / stone pillars etc., are undertaken authentically and in the best interests of the forest. The funds deposited with the FDO/DFO for carrying out such activities should be put to actual utilization only.

ORDER:

In the letter 2nd read above, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), Telangana State, Hyderabad has submitted a proposal under section-2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, for diversion of **0.5873** ha of Forest Land in WLM Eturunagaram division of Mulugu District for Laying of Optical Fibre Cable along the road within the existing Right of way for execution of T-Fibre project in favour of M/s.Telangana Fibre Grid Corporation Limited.

- 2. The proposal has been examined with reference to the guidelines issued by the Government of India in the letter 1^{st} read above.
- 3. Government after careful examination of the proposal and in exercise of the powers delegated to State Government in the guidelines issued by Government of India in the letter 1st read above, hereby accord **in-principle** (Stage.I) approval for diversion of 0.5873 ha of Forest Land in WLM Eturunagaram division of Mulugu District for Laying of Optical Fibre Cable along the road within the existing Right of way for execution of T-Fibre project in favour of M/s.Telangana Fibre Grid Corporation Limited, subject to compliance of the following conditions:
 - i. The legal status of the forest land shall remain unchanged;
 - ii. Demarcation of the forest land diverted: The State Forest Department shall carry out demarcation of the proposed forest area by erecting 4 feet high cement concrete pillars duly numbered at an interval of 20 meters at the cost of the User Agency and cost for which shall be deposited by the User Agency with the forest department as assessed by the concerned District Forest Officer/ Forest Divisional Officer;
- iii. **Net Present Value:** The NPV shall be realized from the User Agency as per Chapter 3 of the F.No.5-2/2017-FC, Dt.28.03.2019 and amendments issued therein vide F.No.5-3/2011-FC(Vol-I), Dt.06.01.2022, Dt.19.01.2022 and Dt.22.03.2022, as the area proposed for diversion is falling within the Eturunagaram Wildlife Sanctuary;

- Compensatory Afforestation: No tree felling is involved, hence no Compensatory afforestation is stipulated.
- v. **Wildlife Mitigation Measures**: An amount of Rs.16.50 Lakhs to be deposited by the User Agency as stipulated in Wildlife clearance by State Board for Wildlife in letter dt:25.02.2022 and other conditions stipulated therein.
- vi. No tree felling and branch cutting shall be carried out by the User agency;
- vii. User Agency shall fulfill the conditions stipulated in Part II, Part III and Part IV and also covering letters, inspections notes of the proposals;
- viii. The depth of the trench shall not be more than 2 m and width shall not be more than 0.45 m and after laying down of optical fiber cable the ground shall be leveled. The cable line should be laid atleast 1.5 meter below the ground;
- ix. Disturbance should be kept minimum by creating labor camps outside the forest areas and it will be responsibility of the User Agency to ensure that the laborers and staff engaged in execution of work do not destruct nearby forest flora and fauna. No labour camp shall be established on the forest land;
- x. Sufficient firewood, preferably the alternate fuel, shall be provided by the User Agency to the labourer after purchasing the same from the State Forest Department or the Forest Development Corporation or any other legal source of alternate fuel;
- xi. The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of Central Government;
- xii. The muck generated in the earth cutting if any, will be disposed off at the designated sites and in no case the muck/ debris will be disposed off in the forest area by the User Agency'
- xiii. The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the project proposal;
- xiv. The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agencies, department or person without prior approval of competent authority;
- xv. Any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Government of India as well as State Forest Department/ PCCF(HoFF) may stipulate from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife, shall be complied by the User Agency;
- xvi. The total forest area utilized for the project shall not exceed **0.5873 ha** and the forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the proposal;
- xvii. The User Agency to make good the land after use/ maintenance;
- xviii. The User Agency to make good any loss to forests / environment;

- xix. The User Agency should take permission for carrying out any maintenance;
- xx. Work should be carried out during day time only;
- xxi. The User Agency and the State Government shall ensure compliance of all the Court orders, provisions, rules, regulations and guidelines for the time being in force as applicable to the project;
- xxii. The compliance report shall be uploaded on e-portal (https://parivesh.nic.in/).
- xxiii. Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and action would be taken as per the MoEF&CC, Guidelines F.No.11-42/2017-FC, Dt.29.01.2018 and as per F.No.5-2/2017, Dt.28.03.2019.
 - 4. After receipt of the compliance on the above mentioned conditions, the proposal will be considered for final approval. This in-principle approval shall be valid for a period of two years from the date of issue of this G.O. in the event of non-compliance of the above conditions, the in-principle approval shall automatically stand revoked after two years.


