With reference to the above I submit that, stage I approval has been accorded by the Government of India under Forest Conservation Act 1980 for diversion of 0.08ha of Forest land in reserve land survey No.600, Srivaikundam Village in Thoothukudi Division for 20MGD closed conduit water supply scheme for the construction of Intake well, foot bridge control room and transformer yard in river Tamirabarani near Srivaikundam of Thoothukudi District vide reference 1st cited.



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In the reference 1* Cited, Principal Chief Conservator of Forests has communicated the copy of Government of India letter in which stage clearance has been accorded for diversion of 0.08 Ha of forest land for 20 MGD closed conduit scheme for Water supply Scheme to Thermal Power Project, SIPCOT complex and other industries in Thoothukudi District and for drinking and Industrial purposes of Thoothukudi Forest Division/District in favor of Executive Engineer, TWAD Board, Thoothukudi District for a period of 30 years subject to certain conditions. Hence this demand note is being sent to you for further action in this matter.

As per the Compensatory Afforestation Scheme, an amount of Rs.1,70,673/- (Rupees One Lakh Seventy Thousand Six Hundred and Seventy Three Only) has to be deposited for creation and maintenance of compensatory afforestation in identified non-forest area to one tenth of the area further as per the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 28/03/2008 and 19/05/2008 and as per the guidelines by the MoEF&CC an Net Present Value amount of

Rs.17,832/- (Rupees Seventeen Thousand Eight Hundred and Thirty Two) has to be deposited. So a total amount of Rs.1,88,505/- (Rupees One Lakh Eighty Eight thousand Five Hundred and Five Only) may be deposited to CAMPA fund only through e-portal (<http://Parvesh.nic.in>). Further, you are also instructed to submit list of documents, certificate and undertakings for compliance of the conditions mentioned below;

1. The legal status of forest land shall remain unchanged;

6. Clearance under FCA, 1980 is limited to diverting to forest area over 0.08 ha for Non-Forestry purpose and water supply/allocation for drinking & Industrial usage shall be regulated as per the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India directions and fortnightly of District Collector, Thoothukudi in the matter be sent to Regional Office also for office records without fail.

However, the Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage Board had violated the provisions under Section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980

in the diverted forest land, by usage of excess forest area of 0.025 ha. and by supply of water to industries other than allowed by the said Government Order. When the revised proposal of the Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage Board mentioned vide subject above was sent to the Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change, Government of India, the Government of India has accorded the Stage-I approval for the said proposal of the Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage Board with one of the conditions that the State Government shall advise the Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage Board not to violate the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 provisions in future and has requested the State Government to send the compliance of the condition.

In the Government Order first read above, orders were issued for diversion of 0.055 ha. of forest land in Sy.No.600 of Srivaigundam Village in Thoothukudi Forest Division to Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage Board, Thoothukudi for construction of intake well along with Control room and foot bridge for drinking water purposes subject to certain conditions.

2. Subsequently, in the Government letter 2nd read above, another proposal for diversion of 0.08 ha of forest land for 20 MGD Closed circuit Scheme for Water supply scheme to Thermal Power Project, SIPCOT complex, Heavy water plant and other industries in Thoothukudi District for drinking and industrial purpose under section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 was forwarded to Government of India, Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change for obtaining their concurrence.

3. In the letter third read above, the Government of India while conveying the Central Government's in-principle approval (Stage-I) for the said diversion of 0.08 ha. of forest land has stipulated as one of the conditions that the State Government shall revoke the orders issued in the Government Order first read above, since the forest area of 0.055 ha is also a part of 0.08 ha.

4. In compliance to the above said condition, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Head of Forest Force) in his letter fourth read above has sent a proposal for revocation of the Government Order first read above and he has requested to issue orders in this regard.




