Yes, except 6 of part-II (Brief note on vulnerability of the forest area to erosion). In fact some portions of the proposed land to be diverted, particularly in Bera Range, have moderate to fairly steep slopes and are therefore vulnerable to erosion. It must be ensured that soil erosion is checked in such portions of land by undertaking soil and water conservation measures and by planting dwarf varieties of tree species along the corridor of the transmission line.

Specific recommendation of concerned Conservator of Forests for acceptance or otherwise the proposal with detailed reasons.	<p>A total of 14.798 ha of forest land is proposed to be diverted for the project for laying of 132 KV Double Circuit transmission line from Chaibasa to Manoharpur in Porahat Forest Division. The extent of forest area involved is 6.510 ha of Protected Forests and 5.775 ha of Reserved Forests while 2.513 ha is Jungle Jhari.</p> <p>The project is in the interest of the State in terms of Power requirement essential for growth and development. Since bare minimum land is proposed to be diverted, the project is recommended for acceptance subject to the following conditions:-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. User agency shall undertake soil and water conservation measures in areas prone to soil erosion at project cost.2. User agency shall plant dwarf varieties of trees in such areas along the corridor of the transmission line in consultation with the Forest Department.

16. Specific recommendation of concerned Conservator of Forests for acceptance or otherwise the proposal with detailed reasons.	The project for laying for 132 KV Double Circuit transmission line from Chaibasa to Manoharpur involves diversion of 4.77 ha of forest land in Kolhan Forest Division (Forest area- 4.215 ha, Jungle Jhari- 0.505 ha). The tract of land along the line of transmission in Jungle Jhari land varies from plain to moderate/gentle slope bearing scrub forest. Forest areas along the line of transmission vary from gentle to moderate slope bearing mixed deciduous forests. The forest area is therefore moderately prone to soil erosion. Since the project is in the interest of the state for meeting requirement of power essential for the growth and development of the state, the project is recommended for acceptance subject to following conditions:- <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. User agency shall undertake soil and water conservation measures in areas prone to soil erosion at Project Cost.2. Plantation of dwarf varieties of tree species shall be undertaken by the user agency at their cost in consultation with the Forest Department.
