


## Site Inspection Report

I inspected the proposed forest land for diversion in Gumo, Visunpur, Chourahi, Mahuadohar, Piprahi, Ghutitand, Kachknal villages on 25.01.2018, 31.01.2018, 06.02.2018 and on 13.02.2018. In koderma forest division 3.8916 ha deemed forest land and 85.7964 ha of notified forest land has been proposed for diversion in order to construct koderma detour under Dankuni to Sonnagar section of eastern dedicated freight corridor in Koderma district. In Visunpur & kachknal villages 3.8916 ha deemed forest land and in Gumo, Chourahi, Mahuadohar, Piprahi and Ghutitand villages a sum of 85.7964 ha notified forest land has been proposed to be diverted. The proposed land is covered with the natural vegetation of Sal, Kend, Piar, Sidha, Neem, Palas, Khair, Gamhar, Seesam, Siris, Bel, Asan, Parmi, Mahua Biyach etc. In Kachknal, 5 trees of date palm are standing on the proposed land.

The proposed site is slightly prone to soil erosion. Birds and animals like, open bill stork, egrets, robin, kingfisher, jungle crow, red jungle fowl, wood peackers, shrikes, grey frankolin, babblers, jungle cat, fox, rock python, karait, cobra spotted deer, Neel gai, wild boar, Jackal, sloth bears, hyena etc. are found in the proposed area. Herd of wild elephants also visit the Kachaknal, Mahuadohar, Ghutitand, Gumo & Chourahi villages / forests.

Forest area proposed in Bisunpur, Gumo & Chourahi comes within 10 K.M. periphery of Koderma Wildlife Sanctuary.
