

Conservation value of protected area –
Sri Penusila Narasimha Wildlife Sanctuary

Sri Penusila Narasimha Wildlife Sanctuary with an area of 1030.85 Sqkms spread over in Kadapa and Nellore Districts comprises a unique and endangered forest type viz, the Dry Deciduous forests, Hilly slopes, rolling forested areas and low valleys make this place worth visiting. The Conservation value of the protected area is marked by the vast flora and fauna as follows.

FLORA: Petrocarpus santalinus, Anogeissus latifolia, Terminalia tomentosa, Hardwickia binata, Chloroxylon swietenia, , Boswellia serrata, Dalbergia paniculata, Zizyphus xylopyrus, etc.

FAUNA: Panther, Sambar, Chowsingha, Sloth Bear, Jackal, Wild Boar, large number of Reptile and Bird species.
