

## SITE INSPECTION REPORT OF B. SUANZALANG, CF(NC) :

The site inspection of land required for diversion for the construction of New BG Railway line from Bairabi to Sairang (Mizoram) 51.300 KM (approx) was done by the undersigned on 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> September, 2012. One careful study, the following observations are made :-

- 1) No Rare/endangered/unique species of flora and fauna is found
- 2) No Protected Archeological/Heritage site/Defense establishment or any other important monument is located along the proposed alignment.
- 3) No Work is carried out in violation of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980
- 4) Certain part of chainage of Railway line passes through Reserved Forest, and the barest minimum requirement of forest land for diversion is 74.4882 Ha. The diversion of this area of forest land has to be done by Government of Mizoram through Revenue Department in agreement with the provision of Forest Conservation Act, 1980 as amended from time to time. The construction of New BG Railway from Bairabi to Sairang (Mizoram) 51.300 KM (approx) would be an important milestone for development of transportation infrastructure in the state and hence beneficial to local people for economic upliftment.
