

SITE INSPECTION REPORT OF THE DCF (TO BE ENCLOSED) SPECIALLY
HIGHLIGHTING FACTS ASK ABOVE IN
Col.7 (xi, xii) 8 and 9 ABOVE:-

The first site inspection was carried out on 17.6.2010 accompanied by DC and Addl. DC, Aizawl and also Pu Romgura Hrahse, Range Officer, Sairang Forest Range. The second site inspection was conducted in presence of representative of Railway, DC, Aizawl, ACF, Aizawl Forest Division and RO, Sairang on 28.10.2011 and the report in respect of co.7 (xi,xii), 8 and 9 is given as under :-

7.(xi): Whether any rare/endangered/Unique species of flora and fauna found in the area – if so, details thereof :- **Since the area in question is located just adjacent to Aizawl – Silchar National Highway, no rare/endangered/unique species of flora and fauna were found at the time of inspection within the area and no signs of such endangered species were detected and as such, there is practically no scope for such species within the said area.**


(xii): Whether any protected archeological/heritage site/defense establishment or any other important monument is located in the area; If so, the details thereof with NOC from competent authority, if required :- **There is practically no protected archeological/heritage site/defense establishment or other important monument within the area.**

a. Whether the requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency in col.2 of Part-I is unavailable and barest minimum for the project. If no, recommended area item-wise with details of alternatives examined.

: **Yes, the requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency in col.2 of Part-I is found unavailable and proposed barest minimum for the project which is quite acceptable in view of the need for construction of Railway line from Bairabi to Sairang.**

b. Whether any work in violation of the Act has been carried out (Yes/No). If yes, details the same including period of work done, action taken on erring officials. Whether work in violation is still in progress.

: **So far violation of The Forest Conservation Act, 1980 were not found within the area at the time of inspection.**
