


SITE INSPECTION REPORT

I, Shri Vanlalsiama Khawlhing, Divisional Forest Officer, Champhai Forest Division, Mizoram had personally verified the forest area proposed for diversion for the construction of Bridge over River Tuivawl on Aizawl – Champhai road on dt. 24.5.2008 and observed that –

- 1) There is no rare/endangered/unique species of flora and fauna found in the area
- 2) There is no protected archeological/heritage site/defence establishment or any other important monument in the area.
- 3) The road which connects Aizawl and Champhai has to cross River Tuivawl and the entire length of both sides of the river up to 800 metres from the River is Notified Reserved Forest which makes the requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency in col. 2 of Part-I unavoidable. The extent of area proposed is also barest minimum.
- 4) There is no violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.
- 5) The proposed area bears only 11 nos. of trees and hence it is open forest.

The Net Present Value of forest @ Rs. 5.80 lakhs per Ha. for the required 1408.50 m² is Rs. 81693.00 only.
