The original proposal of 416.68 ha of forestland was examined and it was found to have some short comings for which the nodal officer was requested to submit the compliance along with relevant papers. Nodal officer has now forwarded the revised proposal for diversion of 509.33 ha of forestland under forest (Conservation) Act 1980 stating therein that user agency has not submitted following documents, e.g

1. Proceeding of Gram Shabha duly attended by forest officials and district officials.
2. Certificate of NOC of Concerned Deputy Commissioner for diversion of Jungle-Jhari forest of revenue department.
3. Details of proposal for diversion of Domodar Perennial Nala to other land with full details & plan.
4. Certificate under FRA, 2006
5. Comments of Chief Wildlife Warden, Jharkhand.
6. Certificate of Environmental Clearance

Thus it recommended to do take the further necessary action for diversion of 509.33 ha of forestland subject to the compliance of the above requirements and submission of necessary documents thereof.
