17. Detailed opinion and specific recommendation of the State Forest Department for acceptance of otherwise of the proposal with remarks

There is no adverse comment made by Conservator of Forests and Deputy Conservator of Forests. The project is important for completion of Tuirial Hydro Electric Project for which final approval had been already granted on 16.3.2000. The area required is only 2 ha. and permanent diversion is not required. Immediately the project (Tuirial HEP) construction is completed, the area could be taken back and reclamation works done. Mizoram is still without adequate power supply and therefore the State Government is eagerly waiting for completion of the project to have ample supply of power. Tuirial HEP is designed to generate 60 MW electricity. It is now the state priority project. In view the fact stated above, the proposal is recommended for approval.
