No.60/6/86-FOR: Whereas it appears to the Govt. of Manipur that the area as specified in the schedule below is required by reason of its adequate ecological, faunal, floral, geomorphological, natural and zoological significance to be constituted as a Wildlife sanctuary for the purpose of protecting, propagating and developing Wildlife or its environment;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section(1) of Section 18 of the Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972 (53 of 72), the Governor of Manipur, hereby declares the said area as Yangoupokpi Lokchao Wildlife sanctuary. Further, as provided under section 19 of Wildlife (Protection Act) 1972, the Collector/Deputy Commissioner (Chandel) shall enquire into and determine the existence, nature and extent of the right of any person in or over the land comprised within the limits of the sanctuary in accordance with procedure laid down in section 21 to 25 of the Act.

SCHEDULE OF YANGOUPOKPI LOKCHAO WILDLIFE SANCTUARY:- " It is bounded by Waksulok to the north, Lokchao river to the South, international boundary pillars from 15 to 22 to the east and to the West the course of the Lokchao river which meets the main Burma road near about Sibong and then following the bridle path going to Leibi and then to a branch of Namjetlok near about Dokabung Kuki, with exclusion of Moreh township covering an area of 100 acre (40 hac.) as notified by the Govt. vide No. 55/9/78-FOR dt. 22-7-78. In extent it will cover roughly about 60 sq. miles (184.8 sq. kms).
