Subject: Up-gradation of Guru Nanak Dev Ji Marg.

Executive Committee for 550th Parkash Utsav Celebrations of Guru Nanak Dev Ji, headed by Hon'ble C.M Punjab in its meeting dated 20.06.2019 has decided that road from Sultanpur Lodhi to Dera Baba Nanak via Batala which is 30 feet wide may be proposed to be designated as Guru Nanak Dev Ji Marg. FD has advised PWD B&R to obtain necessary clearances such as Forest, Utility shifting etc. so that necessary budgetary allocations for construction are made. You are therefore requested to pursue the cases for Forest clearance and utility shifting with concerned departments. As this project is being monitored by State Government at highest level therefore a weekly report on the progress made be submitted to this office regularly.

Subject:- Finalization of alignment of Proposed Guru Nanak Dev Ji Marg.

It has been decided to name the road from Gurudwara Ber Sahib - Sultanpur Lodhi - Kapurthala - Kartarpur - Beas - Batala (including Batala Bypass) - Dera Baba Nanak as Guru Nanak Dev Ji Marg. Total length of this proposed marg is 136.14 km (which includes NH stretches also) & cost of up-gradation to min. 10 mtr. width is Rs. 96.15 cr. The route from Gurudwara Ber Sahib Sultanpur Lodhi to Kapurthala was proposed via Dadwandi.

It has been brought to notice by field staff that this stretch (Gurudwara Ber Sahib Sultanpur Lodhi to Kapurthala via Dadwandi) was earlier named as "Bebe Nanki Marg" during 2009-10, though no formal notification could be traced out. Thus, this stretch overlaps the proposed Guru Nanak Dev Ji Marg. The matter has been discussed with Local MLA Sh. Navtej Singh Cheema Ji, who has suggested that the road from Gurudwara Ber Sahib to Kapurthala (via Tahwandi Chaudharian) - Subhanpur (on G.T road) - Beas - Mehta - Batala (including Batala Bypass) - Dera Baba Nanak be declared as "Guru Nanak Dev Ji Marg". The total length via this route is 126 km. & the cost of the up-gradation to min. 10 mtr. width is 107.64 cr. The route from Beas to Dera Baba Nanak will be the same as per earlier proposal. Map showing the earlier alignment (in red) and revised proposal (in blue) is attached herewith.
