

SITE INSPECTION REPORT OF SRI. D. RAJA RAO, SFS.,  
FOREST DIVISIONAL OFFICER, CHENNUR

I along with the Forest Range Officer, Chennur and concerned staff have inspected the proposed project site of 3296.47 Ha out of which Forest land and 372.53 Ha RF land and Non- Forest land an extent of 2923.94 ha. The RF land is falling in Adriyala RF, Manthani Range of Peddapally District, during the inspection by me on 21.09.2020. for " Clearance to the Cluster of Ramagundam region Coal Mines viz. [GDK No.1&3, 2&2A and 5 Incline, GDK Coal Mine (2&2A and 5 Incline), GDK No.11 Incline, GDK No.7-LEP, Ramagundam Coal Mine (Vakilpalli Mine, Adriyala longwall Project, GDK 10&10A Inclines, RGOC-I Exp. & RGOC-II Ext.) MOCP, RGOC III Exp. Ph-II.] of SCCL in Peddapally Division.

Coal mining activities are being carried out in Ramagundam-I Area from the year 1959, Now it is proposed to convert one of the Underground mines [GDK No.1&3, 2&2A and 5 Incline, GDK Coal Mine (2&2A and 5 Incline), GDK No.11 Incline, GDK No.7-LEP, Ramagundam Coal Mine (Vakilpalli Mine, Adriyala longwall Project, GDK 10&10A Inclines, RGOC-I Exp. & RGOC-II Ext.) MOCP, RGOC III Exp. Ph-II.] for dumping of OB and continuing production of coal from the underground incline mines simultaneously.

The proposed project area is Non- Forest land. Since the project areas is 7.72, 8.02 and 6.07 Kms away from the Core area( Forest Division, Chennur). The proposed areas are located on the upper side of the sanctuary and water of the river flows through the sanctuary. Therefore, mitigation measures are required to prevent any damages in future.



Hence it is recommended for considering the proposal.
