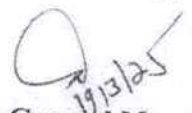

INTRODUCTION

BRIEF OF DIPKA OC EXPANSION PROJECT

The Dipka Opencast Expansion Project is an existing mega opencast project in the thick seam zone of SECL command area. The project is located in Village Dipka, Katghora Tehsil, Korba District of Chhattisgarh State. It is under the administrative control of Dipka Area.

The project has Environmental Clearance for coal production for 37.50MTPA granted by MoEF&CC vide letter J-11015/487/2007-IA-II(M), dated:05th September 2022 in an ML area of 1999.293Ha. Dipka Expansion Project has carried out coal production of 32.149 MTPA in FY 2022-23 & 33.41 MTPA in FY 2023-24 and have an aspirational target for coal production of 40.00 MTPA to meet the growing energy demands of the nation. As per the existing land area the project has a life of 04 years as on 01.04.2024. However, A project report of 40 MTPA with an ML area of 3096.24 Ha has been approved on 24.12.2020 and the additional land is being notified under CBA,1957. This will extend the life of mines to further 21 years.

NEED FOR A FOREST LAND SURRENDER PLAN

MoEF&CC, New Delhi vide letter F. No:8-78/2006FC(pt), dated:12.02.2024 had granted Stage-I FC for the 0.093Ha revenue forest land to be diverted in favour of SECL Dipka in which condition 7 stipulates that: *"Mined out forest areas which are already reclaimed by the user agency, shall be handed over back to the State Forest Department for management and control. The UA shall prepare a land surrender schedule for the surrender of the mined out and biologically reclaimed forest land"*. Further, point 2 of MoEF&CC letter dated:30.09.2024 for the Stage-II FC application for 174.925Ha (originally proposed area 206.638Ha) and point 3 of MoEF&CC letter dated:18.10.2024 for the Stage-II FC application for 33.84Ha stipulates that *"The User Agency shall return/surrender/handover the forest area where mining has already been done and the land is not being used for mining or any other purpose to the State Government. A plan in this regard shall be submitted"*. In order to comply with the conditions of MoEF&CC this forest land surrender plan has been prepared with the help of CMPDIL and SECL HQ and its implementation will be subject approval of competent authority.

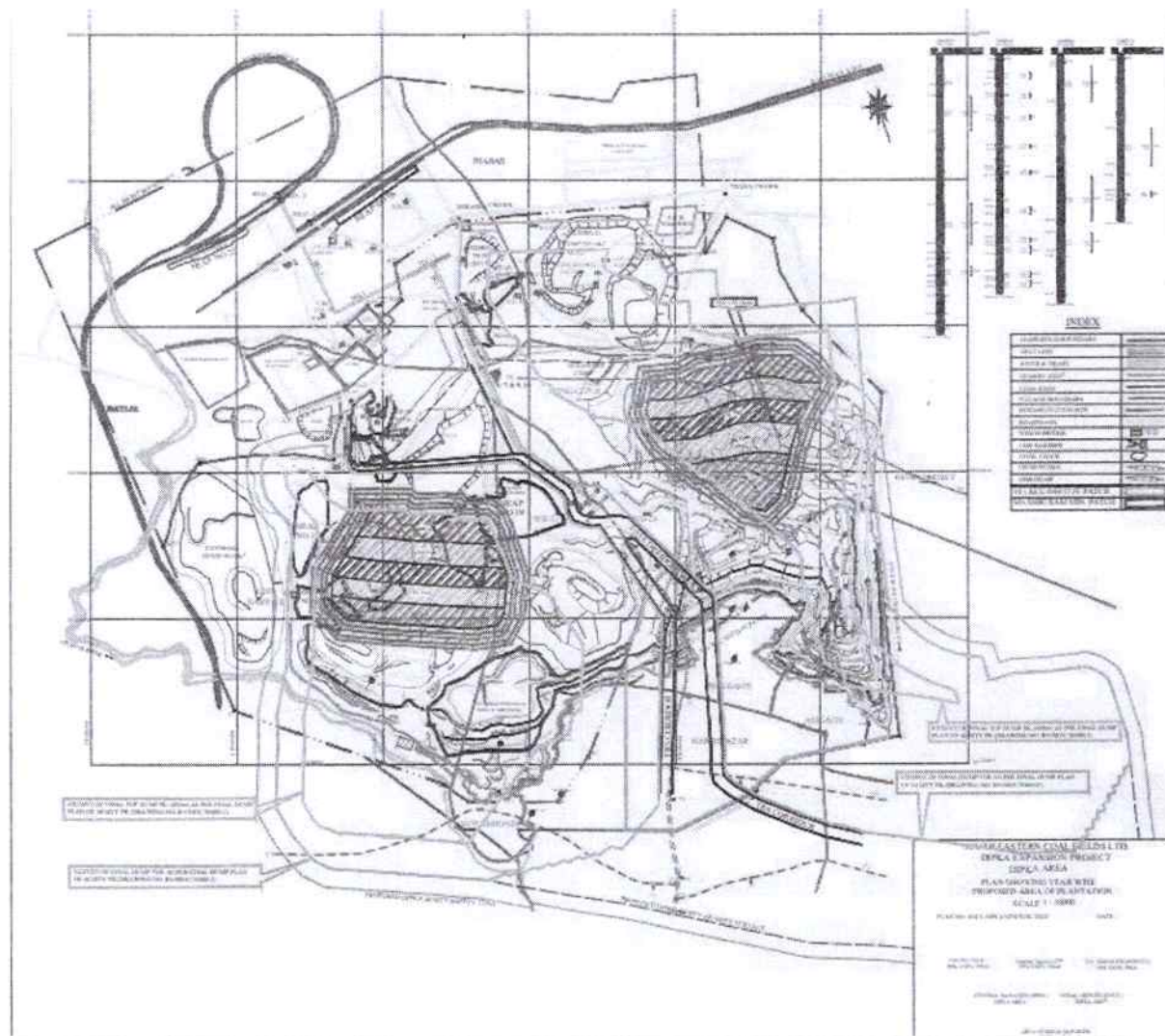
EXISTING FOREST LAND DIVERSION CASES OF DIPKA EXPANSION PROJECT & STATUS OF FOREST CLEARANCE

Dipka OC Expansion Project have Environmental Clearance for 37.50 MTPA within an ML area of 1999.293Ha of which 409.056Ha is revenue forest land. Further, a **mining plan for expansion from 37.50 to 40.00 MTPA has been approved in the 195th meeting of the CoFD**, in which the ML area is 1999.386Ha of which 409.149 ha is revenue forest land. The forest land surrender schedule for the 409.149 Ha is prepared considering the future mining, backfilling, and reclamation of Dipka OC Mines and in line to the progressive & final mine closure of Dipka OC Mines.

PLANNED BACKFILLING AND RECLAMATION OF DIPKA OC MINES



As per the Project Report for 40.00MTPA with the total land of 3096.24Ha, total volume of OB has been estimated as 1672.05 Mcum (including 51.87 Mcum inseam band) (as on 01.04.2020).

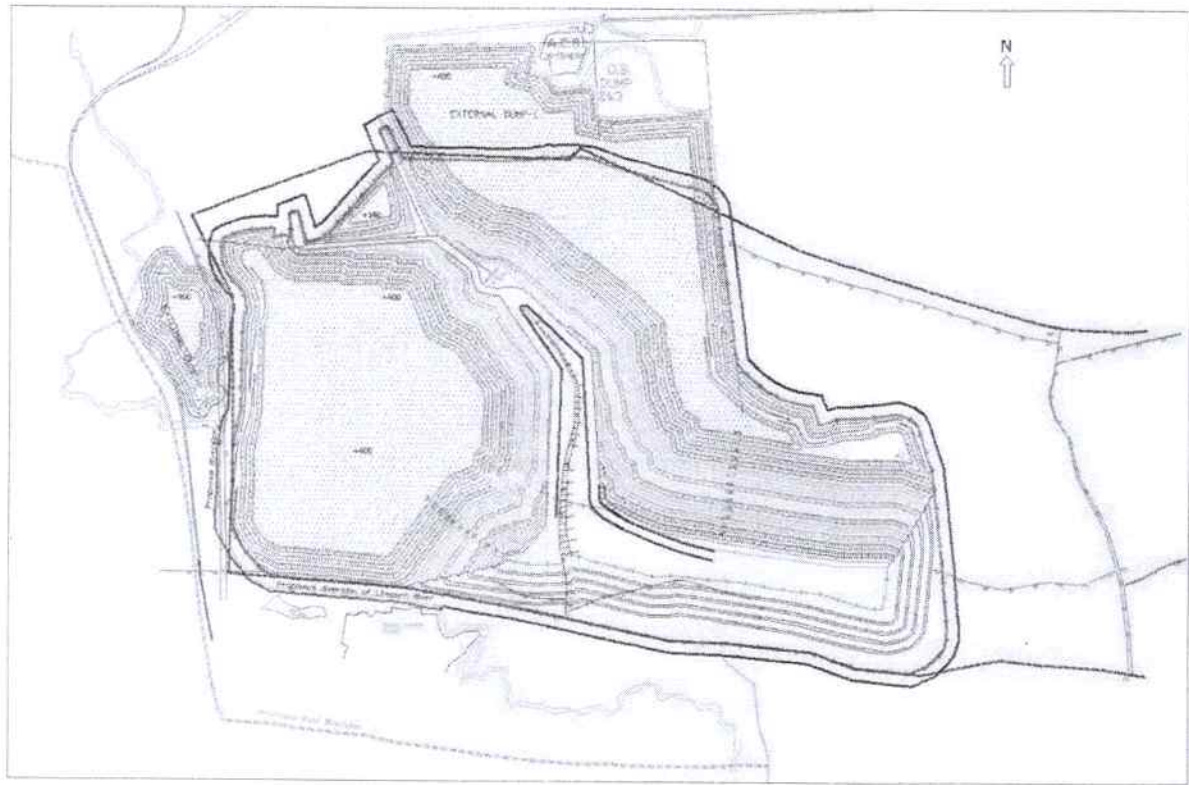
The mining is proposed in a sequence which is ideally suited for achieving the objective of placing maximum possible waste in the internal dumps. By adopting this sequence of mining, as the quarry advances, the amount of external dump will be as minimum as possible and that of internal dump will increase as more space for the economic dumping is created. Presently, internal backfilling is being done in the quarry. The total quantity of OB dumped till 01/04/2020 including both internally and externally is 366.62m³. It is proposed in the PR that the maximum volume of OB will be internally backfilled in the de-coaled void and existing external dumping site by raising its height upto 90m.

The existing Internal dump, due to the position of haul road, has been divided into three parts i.e. Eastern dump, Central dump and Western dump. The maximum height of the proposed internal dumps has been designed up to 90m above the ground level. Hence internal dump is proposed to be dumped upto 400m RL. Initially the top soil will be removed and stored separately. Later on the top soil dumped and the existing top soil will be directly spread and or stored over the levelled graded external dump when the dump reaches its maximum RL.

Dumper/Tipper will transport soil/alluvium OB from the top OB bench and will dump the soil directly on the levelled OB. The breakup of OB quantity to be accommodated in various dumps is as follows :-

Wherever possible, simultaneous land reclamation will be done along with the OB dumping. Once, the internal dumping starts reaching its maximum R.L, the spoil will be graded and landscaped in harmony with surrounding topography and biological reclamation carried out in stages.

About 250m wide final void at the end of the mining operations will be left along the quarry floor. The total final void area left at the end of the mining operations at surface RL (including the space for the main haul road and conveyor layout) will be 883.05Ha.

***Note:-** Dipka Expansion Project is further proposed for expansion in coal production with increased land area. The land acquisition process under CBA, 1957 is underway which will require diversion of an additional 105 Ha of forest land. The Forest Land Surrender Plan/Schedule for the same will be prepared and submitted along with the application for diversion of the said forest land.

CONCLUSION

The Forest Land Surrender Plan for the Dipka Opencast Expansion Project has been developed in compliance with the directives of MoEF&CC, ensuring that reclaimed forest land is systematically returned to the State Forest Department for management and ecological restoration.

The Forest Land Surrender Schedule considers the operational requirements, progressive reclamation, and final mine closure activities of the Dipka OC project. The surrender timeline has been structured to ensure that mined-out areas are biologically reclaimed and stabilized before being handed over to the State Forest Department. The surrender of 409.149 Ha of forest land is planned for 2049-50, aligning with the mine's operational timeline, coal reserve exhaustion by 2046-47, and the subsequent three-year reclamation and closure period. The surrender schedule is tentative and may be adjusted based on the actual progress of mining and future land acquisitions under the CBA Act, 1957.

Through this structured approach, SECL aims to facilitate a smooth transition of reclaimed forest land back to its natural ecosystem while balancing the nation's energy security and environmental commitments.
