Madam/Sir,

I am directed to refer the PCCF (LM) and Nodal Officer, FCA, 1980, Govt. of Madhya Pradesh letter No. F-5/1129/2022/10-11/3278 dated 22.09.2022 on the above cited subject. In this regard following shortcomings have been observed in the information submitted by the State Govt.:

- i. The corrected KML file of the area proposed for diversion has not been uploaded on PARIVESH portal.
 - ii. It has been informed that 10(ten) villages located in the core area of the Ratapani wildlife Sanctuary are under consideration for relocation. Therefore the plan for relocation of these villages along with a single KML file depicting the location of each village and the boundary of the wildlife sanctuary shall be submitted.
2. It is therefore requested that the information on shortcomings, as indicated above, may be submitted for further consideration of the proposal.
