Background note of the proposal-

- 1. The Ministry was issued earlier approval vide letter no. 8-87/2001-FC dated 20.12.2005 (p-56-57/c) for **285.89 ha** of forest land for Shanti Khani Extension Block underground mining in favour of M/s SCCL in Adilabad District of Andhra Pradesh State. The present proposal is for **for sinking of Man Winding Shaft and essential infrastructure in Shantikhani Long Wall Project in Mandamarri area.** Since, it pertains to diversion of additional area of the same proposal.
- 2. Further it is submitted that the State Government of AP (now TG) was submitted a proposal vide letter no. 17950/2005/F1 dated 10.11.2005 for diversion of 4.88 ha of forest land in Benampally Forest Division for Shaft Sinking of Shanti Khani Long Wall Project in favour of M/s SCCL in which Ministry was accord "In-principle" approval on 18.07.2006 (p-218/c) and Final approval on 14.07.2008 (p-47-48/c).
- 3. After examination the proposal, the following information are not found:
 - **a.** Forest cover map is not given.
 - **b.** SOI Toposheet and DGPS map for CA is not given.
 - c. Site suitability certificate is not given.
- **4.** In view of the above facts related to the proposal, it is proposed that proposal may be placed before FAC for its consideration in its forthcoming meeting scheduled to be held on 26.10.2018.
