Sub: Diversion of 150.00 ha of Forest Land in favour of Madhya Pradesh Tourist Development Board, Bhopal for establishment of Chidiyatol Zoo and Rescue Centre in Raisen District Madhya Pradesh State. (Online proposal No.FP/MP/OTHERS/32757/2018).

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the letter No.F-5/820/2018/10-11/3678 dated 15th November, 2019 of APCCF (LM) and Nodal Officer, FCA, 1980, Govt. of MP received via email on dated 11.12.2020 on the above subject forwarding a report on the compliance of conditions stipulated in the Stage-I approval dated 20.07.2018 and to say that on examination of the said report in the Ministry revealed following shortcomings: -

- i. The User Agency has not submitted an undertakings of the conditions No. (i) to (xxvi) of the Stage -I approval letter dated 20.07.2018.
- ii. The State Govt. has not submitted a certificate for CA is suitable and free from all encroachments and other encumbrances in respect of this condition.
- iii. The State Govt. has not submitted a copy of Survey of India toposheet of 1:50,000 scale map for land identified for the purpose of CA.
- iv. The State Govt. has not submitted a copy of Cost-benefit analysis report in accordance with the MOEF&CC guidelines dated 01.08.2017. The same is required before Stage-II approval.
- v. The State Govt. has not submitted a copy of tree enumeration list as per project lay out be submitted to arrive at minimum tree felling figure. The same is required before Stage-II approval.
- vi. The Complete compliance of FRA, 2006 with the gram sabha resolution has not submitted by the State Government.

- vii. As per the State Govt. letter dated 15.11.2019, it has been reported that the amount deposited for CA is Rs. 90,85,999/-. However as per the State Govt. letter dated 16.05.2018, it has been mentioned that the CA scheme is prepared for Rs. 90, 52, 999/-. This needs clarification.
- viii. The Land use plan approved by the CZA shall be submitted.

In view of the above, the State Government of Madhya Pradesh is requested to furnish the above mentioned information to this Ministry for further consideration of the proposal for grant of Stage-II approval.
