- 2. The proposal is for obtaining general approval under Section 2 (iii) of FCA, 1980 in accordance with the instructions of Government of India communicated vide their letters dt.17/11/2016 and 16/11/2016 for 229.00 ha forest land for Limestone mining in Dist. Chandrapur.
- 3. The Government of India vide letter dt.17/11/2016 conveyed that the Ministry has decided that the user agency seeking permission under section 2(iii) of Forest Conservation Act, 1980 shall apply online on the prescribe form which is available on http://forestclearnce.nic.in/ website. The detail guidelines/procedure for submission of application is available on website. In this regard only online application, will be considered by Ministry.
- 4. Approval under Section 2 (ii) of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for the forest land included in the total mining lease area has not previously been obtained.



- 5. As reported by the Deputy Conservator of Forest, Central Chanda Division, Chandrapur the area belongs to Eco-value class-III having density below 0.4 and Tropical Dry Deciduous Forest.
- The proposed project is not falling in the Eco Sensitive Zone of the Protected Area as reported by Deputy Conservator of Forests, Central Chanda Division, Chandrapur.
- 7. The area involved in the project does not form part of any existing National Park, Wildlife Sanctuary, Nature Reserve etc as reported by the Deputy Conservator of Forests, Central Chanda Division, Chandrapur.
- 8. The User Agency has submitted the undertaking for payment of NPV of the forest land allowed to be utilized for the mining lease, against the forest land proposed for diversion.
- 9. There is no violation of Forest (Conservation) Act 1980, as reported by the Deputy Conservator of Forests, Central Chanda Division, Chandrapur.
- 10. The area involved in the project is not likely to affect monumental site of cultural, historical, religious, archeological or recreational importance as reported by Deputy Conservator of Forests Central Chanda Division, Chandrapur.
- 11. The User Agency has submitted the certificate of Collector, Chandrapur under Schedule Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dweller's (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act 2006 issued vide letter No. RB-2/2016/52 dt.30/3/2016 in prescribed format Form- II for the proposed 190.42 ha forest land as per Government of India guidelines dated 5/7/2013. However, the process for settlement of the rights under the FRA Act 2006 for the remaining 38.58 ha forest land is under progress.
- 12. The User Agency has submitted the Geo digital map in suitable scale with georeference boundary in shape file prepared by using total stations or differential GPS and also indicated forest land, non-forest land & adjoining land for general approval under Section 2 (iii) of FC Act, in different colors.
- 13. The Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests & Nodal Officer, Maharashtra State, Nagpur has recommended the proposal subject to the conditions, given in his specific recommendations, under Section-2 (iii) of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. His specific recommendations are enclosed in the proposal.
- 14. In the circumstances explained in the aforesaid paragraphs and enclosures, the State Government recommends that Government of India may kindly be moved for general approval under section 2 (iii) of forest (Conservation) Act,1980 for 229.00 ha. forest land for Limestone mining at village Naokari-Kusumbi, Dist. Chandrapur and the same may please be obtained & communicated to this Government at earliest.
