## Madam/Sir,

With reference to above mentioned subject and your letter no. F-3/97/2018/10-11/12/4300 dated 17.12.2020, I am directed to inform that after examination of the said reply in the Ministry, the following has been observed:

- I. The State Govt. once again has not submitted the plan addressing the issue of shifting of transmission line.
- II. As per DSS analysis report the following has been reported:
  - a. The actual forest land involved in the submergence is found 501.22 ha. instead of 467.99 ha. or 466.52 ha (as per shape-file) mentioned in the instant proposal. Therefore, as per GIS-DSS analysis the total forest involved in the instant proposal is found 530.80 Ha.
  - b. The user agency has left many forest patches/area's while preparing the forest diversion map and due to this reason the actual forest area coming under the submergence was found 466.53 ha instead of 501.22 ha.
