- 26. Recommendations of the site inspecting officer: Based on the above facts the proposal is recommended with following conditions:
 - i. No Non-Site-Specific activities will be carried out by the User Agency on forest land.
 - ii. User Agency will fell minimum number of trees from the forest area.
 - iii. User Agency will not allow any direct discharge from the project site to the Dam water.
 - iv. Ghatol DFL site is situated on plateau, which is good grass land having heavy biotic pressure. It is therefore recommended that the area should be properly fenced and plantation should be done after carrying out proper soil-moisture conservation (SMC) works.
