**Subject: Proposal for diversion of 407.8227 ha. of forest land in favour of M/s Greenko Energies Private Limited (GEPL) for the construction of Shahpur (1800 MW) Pumped Storage Project in Hanumanthkhera, Maunawili villages, G.P.- Mundiyyar, Tehsil-Shahbad, Baran District, Rajasthan. (Online proposal No. FP/RJ/HYD/121439/2021)– regarding.**

Madam/Sir,

Please refer to Government of Rajasthan letter No. 1 (77) Van/2023 dated 10<sup>th</sup> March, 2026 on the above mentioned subject. In this regard, the compliance report submitted by the Government of Rajasthan has been examined in the Ministry. The observations of the Ministry are as follows:-

(i) In compliance with Condition No. (iii) of the Stage-I approval, the State Government shall ensure that the amount for the Wildlife Conservation Plan is deposited in the CAMPA account.

(ii) In compliance with Condition No. (x) of the Stage-I approval, the State Government shall ensure complete compliance with the condition. If, due to technical reasons, the State Government is unable to comply with the condition, a proposal for modification of the condition, along with proper justification may be submitted.

(iii) In compliance with Condition No. (xiv) of the Stage-I approval, the User Agency shall submit a plan for power evacuation and for meeting the existing power requirements. Further, the State Government shall submit a certificate ensuring that the alignment is selected in such a way that only the bare minimum forest land is involved.

(iv) In compliance with Condition No. (xxvii) of the Stage-I approval, the State Government shall ensure complete compliance with the condition. If, due to technical reasons, the State Government is unable to comply, a proposal for modification of the condition, along with proper justification may be submitted.

(v) In compliance with Condition No. (xxviii) of the Stage-I approval, the State Government shall ensure complete compliance with the condition. If, due to technical reasons, the State Government is unable to comply, a proposal for modification of the condition, along with proper justification may be submitted.

(vi) In compliance with Condition No. (xxix) of the Stage-I approval, the State Government shall submit a copy of the Environmental Clearance under the Environment Impact Assessment Notification, 2006, issued under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

Further, the State Government is requested to submit the latest status of the court case (DBCWP No. 17161/2024) pending before the Hon'ble High Court of Rajasthan.

In view of the above, it is requested to furnish the above information/documents at the earliest for further examination of the proposal in the Ministry.
