Sir,

On the above subject and reference it is submitted that the proposed area for diversion of 33.84 ha of broken up forest land (out of total 424.429 ha of forest land in lease area) of Deepka Expansion open cast mining project was inspected on 15.04.2024 and 16.04.2024. Detailed report of the diverted area and CA sites along with relevant photographs are enclosed for perusal. The salient features observed in the proposal and the sites are:

- i. **Delay:** The PP has completed mining in the proposed mining area. It had received Stage-I approval in 2006, but has not complied with the conditions till date.
- ii. CA: The CA land has been stipulated as 70.00 ha degraded land, which were inspected by this office. Only 32 ha area was found suitable for plantation. Now, the User Agency has agreed to provide NFL from its plantation area in tenancy land. So far it has not identified the land. There is a huge time gap between initial violation and implementation of the CA scheme, which has inflicted huge ecological loss.
- iii. **Safety zone:** The PP has not constructed the safety zone properly. Safety zone was found at places in breaks along the boundary. The safety zone is currently present in

part of Eastern portion demarcating the Gevra OCP, part of north and part of western boundary. There is no safety zone in the advancing front. The boundary is about 15 km, whereas the safety zone is about 5.2 km. This is against the mining safety norms besides the FC condition.

- iv. **Top soil management**: During the site inspection, it was observed that top soil management by the agency is quite poor. There is no proper dumping of top soil and it is getting mixed with sub-soil. This leads to poor growth of plants. Topsoil on the overburdened site was found very thin and is vulnerable to erosion.
- v. Soil conservation: During the inspection it was observed that overburdened site is getting eroded and top soil is getting washed. Deep gullies and ravines formations were found, which are expanding every year. The slopes are getting steeper due to erosion, which need to be stabilized urgently by combination of mechanical means and plantation.
- Wildlife management plan: In pursuant to the Stage-I condition, the PP has got Wildlife Conservation Plan prepared by Tropical Forest Research Institute, Jabalpur. As informed by the PP, they have provided fund for the purpose; however, there is no information on implementation of the plan.
- vii. Species composition: Monoculture is to be avoided. Earlier plantations had many pure patches of *Cassia Siamea*. However, current plantations are improved ones, with mixed with number of local species like Sal, Pongamia, Bauhinia, Ficus, Gmelina etc. It was observed that there is a need to enhance technical knowledge related to forestry within SECL and to address the shortage of forestry technical experts. This would enable SECL for quality plantation. During the site inspection, it was observed that SECL has planted Sal seedlings in the non-coal barring area in the years 2022-23.

As stated above, the UA has to complete safety zone and provide CA land. The UA has to surrender the land not being used for mining or any other purpose. Additional penalty may be imposed for continued mining prior to Stage-II approval.

The project proponent applied for renewal of FC proposal vide application registration no: BLS/KOR/KTG/MJM/2004/010 dated: 21.07.2004 and was granted Stage-I for renewal of the proposal vide Ministry letter dated:03.03.2010. The entire forest area of 33.84Ha has been broken by the user agency and mining/ infrastructure/ road were developed before grant of Stage-I for renewal of the proposal.






Fig. 1. 33.84Ha of revenue forest land for Dipka Expansion Open Cast Mining Project (Demarcated in yellow colour)

# Whether forest area proposed for diversion is important from wildlife point of view or not.

No, wildlife belonging to category of Schedule-I and Schedule-II of the Wildlife Protection Act, 1972 has not been reported within a distance of 10KM from the boundary of the proposed area for diversion. It has been further informed by representative of User Agency that as per EC conditions, Wildlife Management Plan has been prepared and approved by PCCF, Wildlife. Payment of Rs.15.47 Crores was paid by User Agency to CAMPA fund on 01.03.2023(Annexure-2).

### 5. Vegetation:-

Total number of trees to be felled. Total 40 nos. trees proposed to be felled in the forest land 33.840Ha comprising of different species.

### 6. Background note on the proposal.

The Dipka OCM is an existing mega opencast project in the thick seam zone of SECL command area. Presently, DipkaOCM is having Environment Clearance for coal production of 37.50 MTY. Dipka OC has acquired 1999.293Ha of land, in which 12 villages are involved namely, Sirki, Beltikiri, Chainpur, Jhingatpur, Suwabhondi, Malgaon, Dipka, Jhabar, Renki, Ratija, Amgaon and HardiBazaar. As per approved PR shovel-dumper mining system has been adopted to excavate OB by departmental HEMM, while extraction of coal is being done by Surface Miner on outsourced basis. The hired surface miners cut would produce coal of (-) 100 mm size by windrowing method. The (-) 100mm coal would be transported by Inpit belt conveyors. Considering the quantum of coal produced from the mine Silos are constructed for rapid loading & dispatch.

# 7. Compensatory afforestation: -Whether land for compensatory afforestation is suitable from plantation and management point of view or not.

The User Agency has informed that during the Stage-II approval dated: 31.07.1995, the proposed CA land as NFL was identified at Bhind District, MP. Further Stage-I FC (Renewal) was granted by MoEF&CC vide letter dated:03.03.2010. While scrutiny of compliances of Stage-I FC it was confirmed by APCCF (LM), Bhopal, MP that amount for CA has been deposited by SECL but CA was done for other projects in that area but not for SECL. CCF (LM), Raipur vide their letter dated: 30.06.2012 instructed DFO Katghora to identify CA in DFL and raise demand accordingly. Further, User Agency has informed that CA land was identified at Basna Range (OA-296) over a degraded forest land of 67.768 Ha in the year 2016. However, the same was utilized for other FDA projects.

The CA land of 69.50Ha was then identified at Bagbahara Range (OA-202, 475, 199, 198, 170) Mahasamund Forest Division in 2022 and DFO Mahsamund has provided Site suitability certificates. **The CA sites was inspected by this office and inspection report is enclosed**. Whereas, Ministry vide letter dated:16.01.2024 has raised query regarding NFL for CA Land, accordingly UA has informed that SECL has identified ACA site at Kurasia OC and is under process.

The entire forest area of 33.84Ha has been broken by the user agency for mining/ infrastructure/ road were developed before grant of Stage-I for renewal of the proposal.

According to the given information, the lease boundary of Dipka Mines, whose total length on KML basis is 18 km, out of which safety zone plantation has been done in about 5.200 kilometers, which has been done by the Chhattisgarh Rajya Van Vikash Nigam (CGRVVN), Where Peltophorum and some mixed species like Sagon, Kasaud, Sissoo, Neem, Karanj, Bamboo, Jamun, Arjuna, Satvan were planted in most of the areas.

1. During the inspection, the concerned officials said that there is rehabilitation site and encroachment on the **Northern side Sirki village** of the lease boundary, due to which the green belt could not be developed.



2. During the inspection, it was observed that a safety zone of 700 meters has been planted in the North-west direction (Sirki village) of the lease boundary, whose width is 7.5 meters, in which different types of plants have been planted, whose average height is 15-16 feet and diameter is 15-20 centimeters. Fencing was found damaged at some places due to encroachment and biotic pressure.





During the inspection it was observed that on the Western side of the lease boundary 1.00 kilometers safety zone (Sirki village) has been planted, whose width is 7.5 meters, in which mix plants species like Teak, Peltophorum, cassia siamea, Karanj, Siras have been planted, whose average height is 20-25 feet and diameter is 30-40 centimeter. Along with safety zone plantation, Chhattisgarh State Forest Development Corporation has also planted trees in the area whose average height is 20-25 feet and diameter is 30-40 centimeters and casualty replacement has been done in which mainly Sal, Peepal, Bamboo, Mundi species have been planted which are protected by fencing Thus the plantation is in good condition with 80-85% survival.

Due to which the natural plants growth and regeneration is being affected.

About 1.5 kilometer long safety zone (Hardibazar road) plantation was done along the road. Whose average height is 12-16 feet and diameter is 15-20 centimeter. Safety zone's plantations fencing were found damaged at some places.



6. There is Gevra Mines on the eastern side of Deepka Lease Boundary, there is a road of about 50 meter wide between both the mines through which loaded vehicles and people of Hardibazar villages travel. 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
