Please refer to Government of Rajasthan letter No. P.1(77) Van/2023 dated 21.05.2026 received through e-mail dated 27<sup>th</sup> May, 2026 on the above mentioned subject. In this context, as per para 1.6 (i) of Consolidated guidelines issued under Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhinyam, 1980 and Van (sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Rule, 2023 made thereunder:-

- i. As per the provisions of the clause (iii) of sub-section (3) of Section 4 of the Compensatory Afforestation Fund Act 2016, the monies realized from the User Agency in compliance of conditions stipulated in the approval granted under the Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhinyam, 1980 are to be deposited into the State/UT specific CAMPA accounts maintained in the Union Bank of India, New Delhi and managed by the National Authority (CAMPA). The State Government/UT Administration shall also ensure adherence to aforementioned provisions and that complete amount of compensatory levies, estimated for implementation of Wildlife Management Plan, Catchment Area Treatment Plan, or any other Plan, shall be deposited into the CAMPA account, managed by the National Authority;

In view of the above, the State Government is requested that the amount for the Wildlife Management Plan shall be deposited in the CAMPA account.
